1. CHAIR'S REPORT: College Curriculum Committee Chair – J. Young

Chair Young thanked the committee for agreeing to meet to review and vote on two important time sensitive matters. She welcomed R. Padilla who is representing the Counseling Division and mentioned that Z. Murdock is the new CCC representative for the Natural Sciences Division.

2. CURRICULUM REVIEW

Chair Young directed the CCC to the Consent Agenda where 13 Art courses were listed. She explained that, as a result of extensive consultation with the various entities on campus, and effective July 1, 2020, these courses have been reassigned to a new division, department, and will receive a new subject code. Art History has been designated as a department separate from the Art Department and has been moved to the Behavioral and Social Sciences Division. She further explained that it is necessary to approve these changes this month to meet Board and spring 2021 schedule development deadlines.

CURRICULUM DISCUSSION

A. Consent Agenda Proposals

It was moved by M. Chaban, seconded by J. Minei, that the committee approve the changes to the division, department, subject code, and to reaffirm the current conditions of enrollment and course delivery methods. The motion carried.

3. DISTANCE EDUCATION ADDENDUM REVISIONS

Chair Young explained that, based on the COVID-19 pandemic, colleges were instructed to submit blanket temporary emergency addenda to the Chancellor's Office for spring, summer, and fall for courses not formally approved for distance education delivery. Now, the Chancellor's Office is requiring that all courses be formally approved for online delivery, even if departments do not have immediate plans to offer them as such, as of December 2020.

In order to comply with this requirement, it was proposed that the Distance Education Addendum be revised to include a third choice for emergency situations. After a robust discussion, the CCC determined that the verbiage should read "Emergency Approval Only: This course is approved for online and/or hybrid delivery in the event of an emergency declared by the Governor or Chancellor's Office." The committee discussed adding an option to the Distance Education Addendum to revoke a previously approved distance education delivery method not approved through emergency status. Faculty opposed this action.

It was moved by M. Chaban, seconded by E. Ambrosio, that the committee approve the revision to the Distance Education Addendum. The motion carried.
