5. BP/AP 4020 REVIEW

Chair Young presented a draft of AP/BP 4020 Program, Curriculum, and Course Development. The two documents are being reviewed and revised at the request of the Academic Senate Ed Policies Committee and are required for certification by the Chancellor's Office. Prior to developing the drafts presented at today's meeting, a subcommittee consisting of the Academic Senate President, Curriculum Advisor, Curriculum Chair, Associate Dean of Academic Affairs, and the Articulation Officer reviewed samples from other colleges and the Community College League of California (CCLC) template. The CCC reviewed the documents and provided edits and suggestions which will be presented to the Vice President of Academic Affairs for further review. Next, the AP/BP will be forwarded to the Academic Senate, the Council of Deans, and then to the Board for approval.
