Photovoltaic Technician

Course Overview:

The Photovoltaic Technician Career Prep course covers the principles of photovoltaics and how to effectively incorporate PV systems into stand-alone or interconnected electrical systems. The content includes system advantages and disadvantages, site evaluation, component operation, system design and sizing, and installation requirements and recommended practices. Common scenarios and procedures are discussed throughout.

Lesson 1: Introduction to Photovoltaic Systems. In this lesson you will learn about the concerns regarding the future and security of the world's energy supply, renewable resources such as solar power are becoming increasingly important. Various solar energy technologies have been used through millennia of human history. However, practical photovoltaic (PV) — the direct conversion of solar energy into electricity — has a history of only about 50 years. This field of study and the resulting industry has been rapidly growing and improving and are expected to become a significant part of the world's energy future.

As the world's shift away from reliance on fossil fuels the Wind Energy Industry leads the way. In just a few short decades wind energy has evolved dramatically. Technological advances now make wind energy a cost-effective solution for the world's ever-growing energy needs. The United States leads in the overall wind power capacity. As the wind energy industry continues to expand in the United States and around the globe, it will provide many opportunities for workers in search of new careers. These careers extend beyond the wind farm and include the efforts of employees who work in manufacturing plants, offices, and construction, as well as operation and maintenance.

This course provides learners with an overview of wind-energy history, basic concepts, costs, and uses. It is designed for the novice and emphasizes an overview of wind-energy conversion and applications of various wind-turbine systems. Phlebotomy Technicians are in demand as one of the fastest growing occupations in healthcare. Launch your career as a Phlebotomy Technician, collecting blood samples from patients in a

hospital, clinical laboratory, medical office, or clinic. Through lectures and hands-on training, learn what you need to know about the circulatory system, venipuncture technique and specimen collection, risk factors and complications, and quality assurance. Students must pay an additional \$125 to sit for the the national exam and must pass the exam and submit all paperwork before being placed for externship. Placement will be coordinated by AUMT and will take place in a one week 40-hour schedule Monday - Thursday. Expected externship completion/program completion is one month after the final class meeting. Students must be at least 18 years old and have their HS Diploma or equivalent prior to enrolling.

El Camino College Community Education department's 168-hour, 10 & 1/2-week, program provides a 3-part approach to train you for a California Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) and prepare you to pass the DMV behind-the-wheel exam to earn your Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL). Once you obtain your Class A California Commercial Driver's License, you will be eligible for entry-level employment positions in the trucking industry. The program is all-inclusive priced at \$6,499. The program is divided into three parts and includes all class materials, usage of truck for training and testing, DMV fees, hazardous material endorsement, double/triple endorsement, tank endorsement and TWIC Card. Part 1 prepares you for the knowledge tests to obtain your commercial learner's permit. Part 2 provides the hands-on behind-the-wheel Range training. Part 3 provides the hands-on behind-the-wheel Public Road training and testing at the DMV. 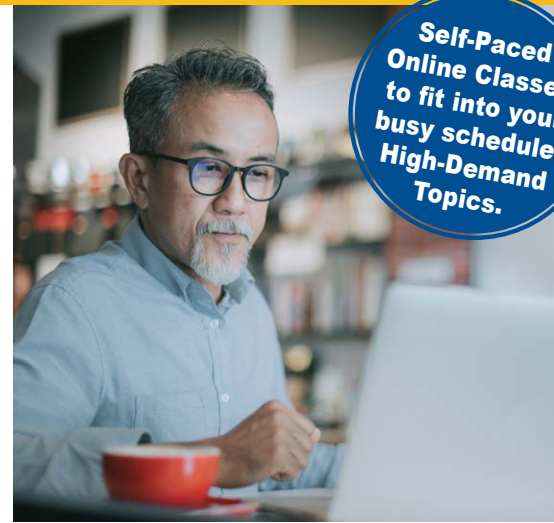

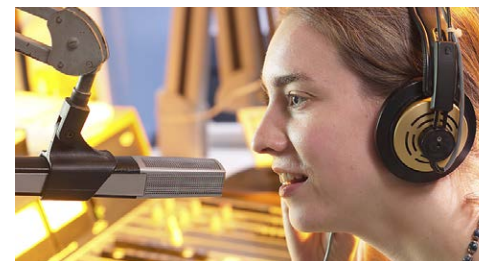

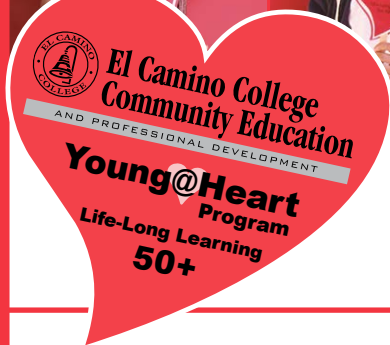
