Seats Filled – 1,083

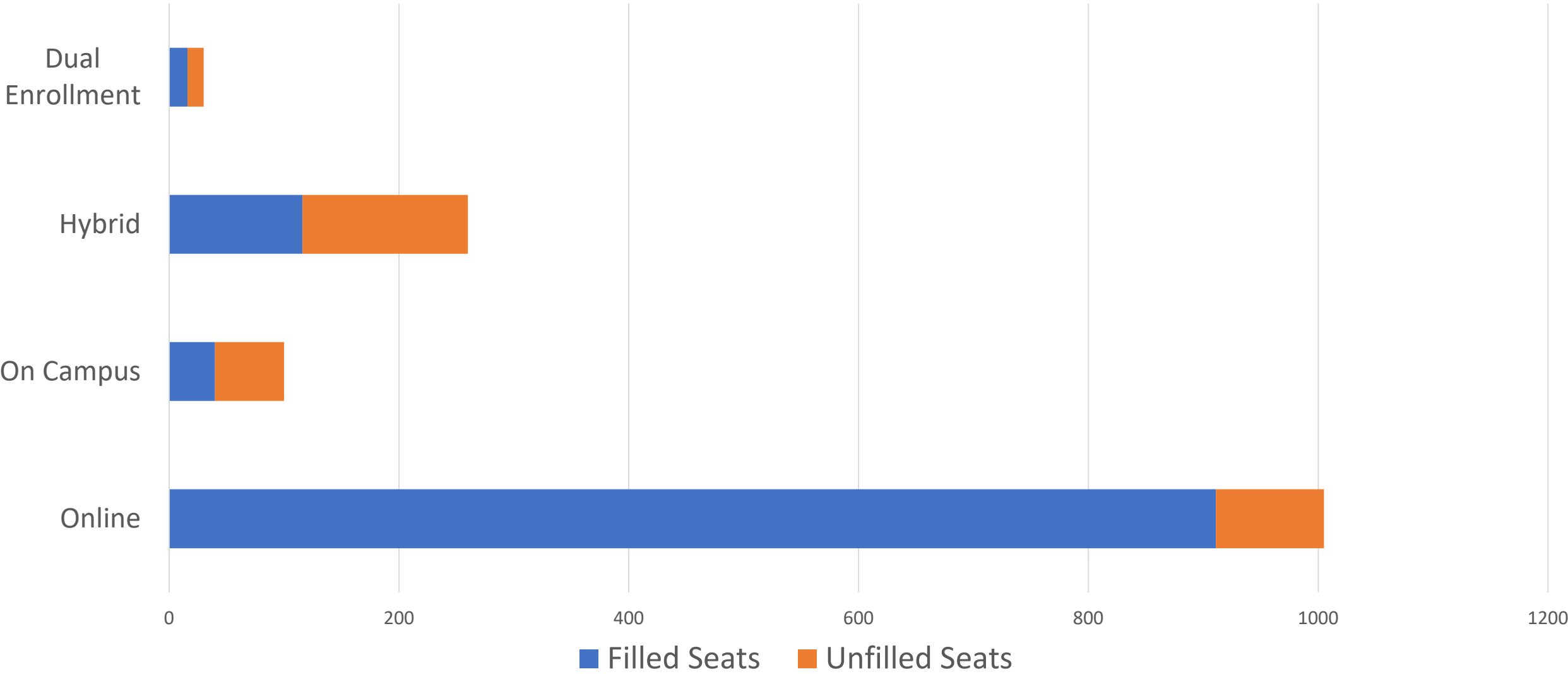
Overall Fill Rate – 84% fill rate

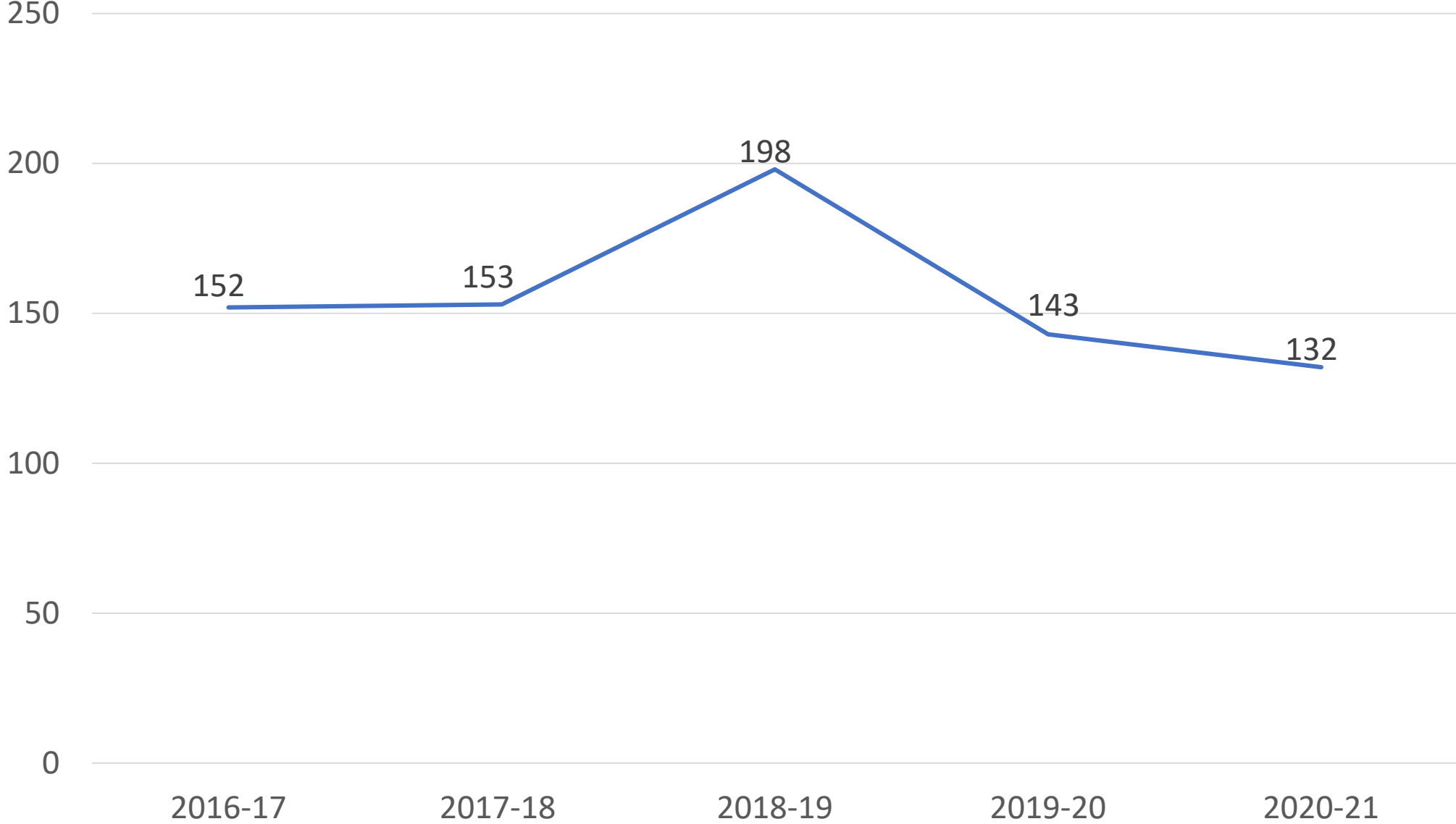

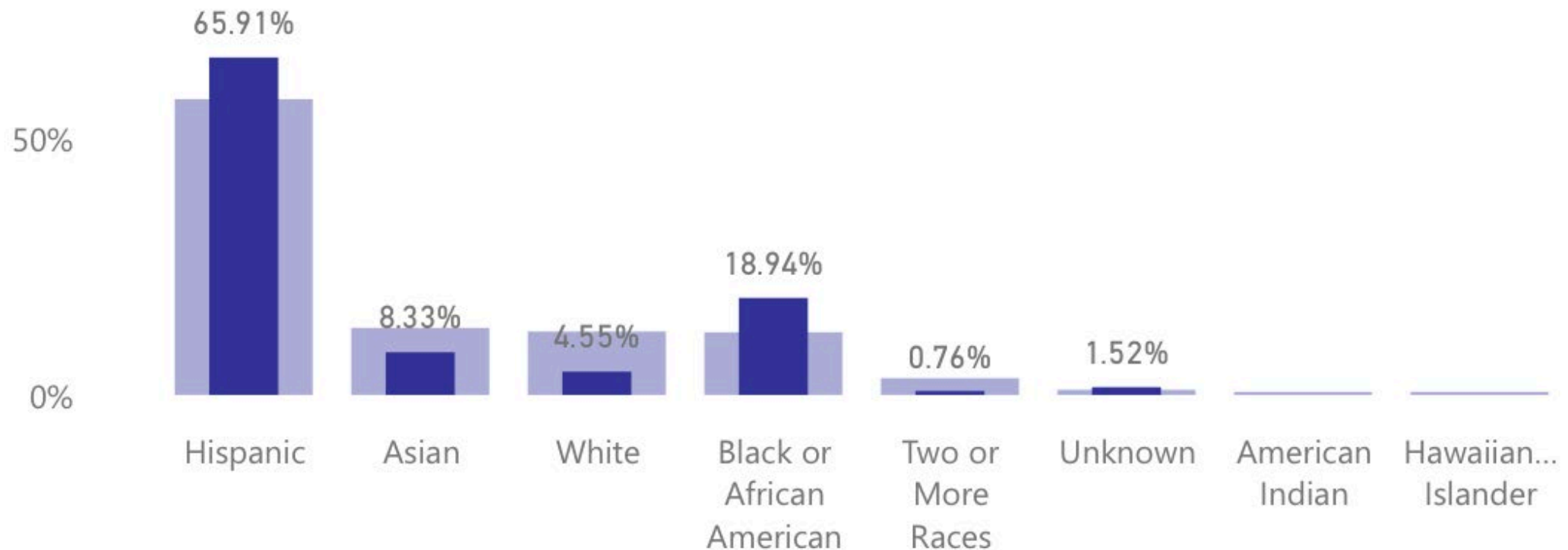

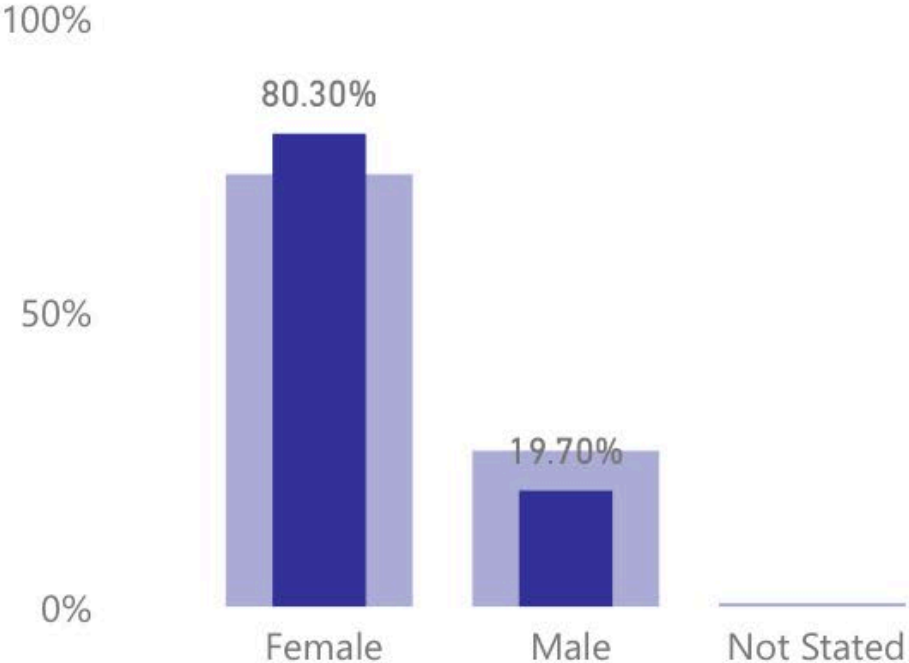
Ethnicity of 2021 Sociology AAT Awardees (dark blue bar)

(in comparison to BSS AAT awardees – light blue bar)

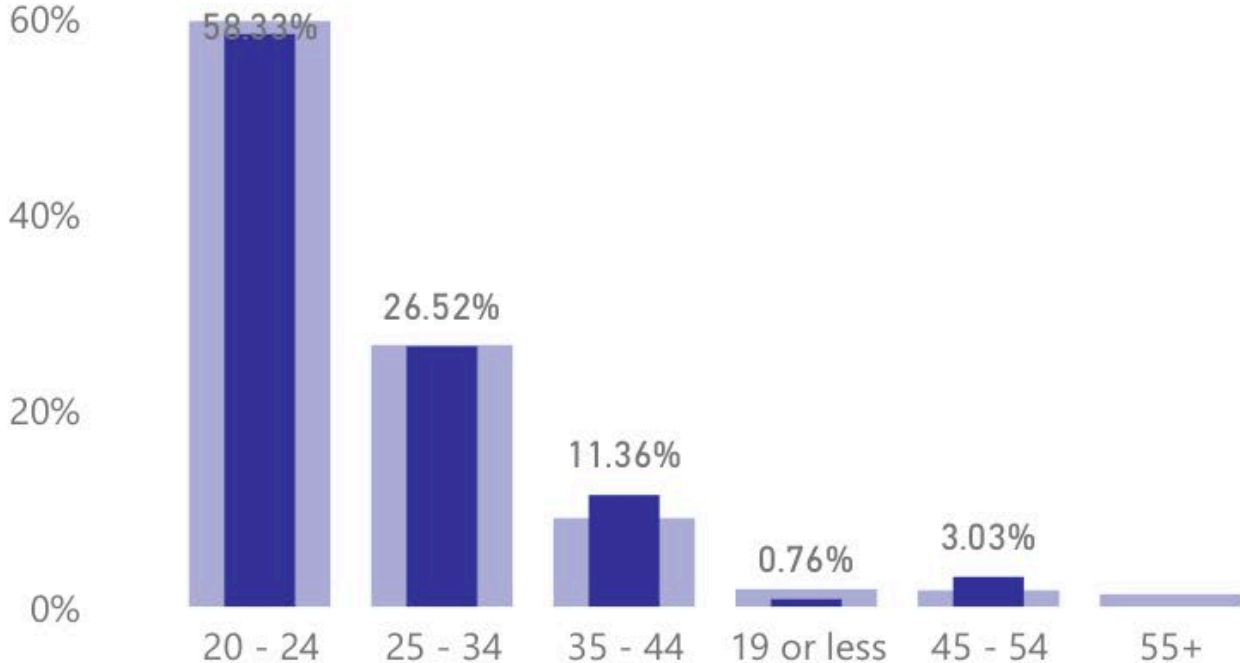
Ethnicity of Awardees



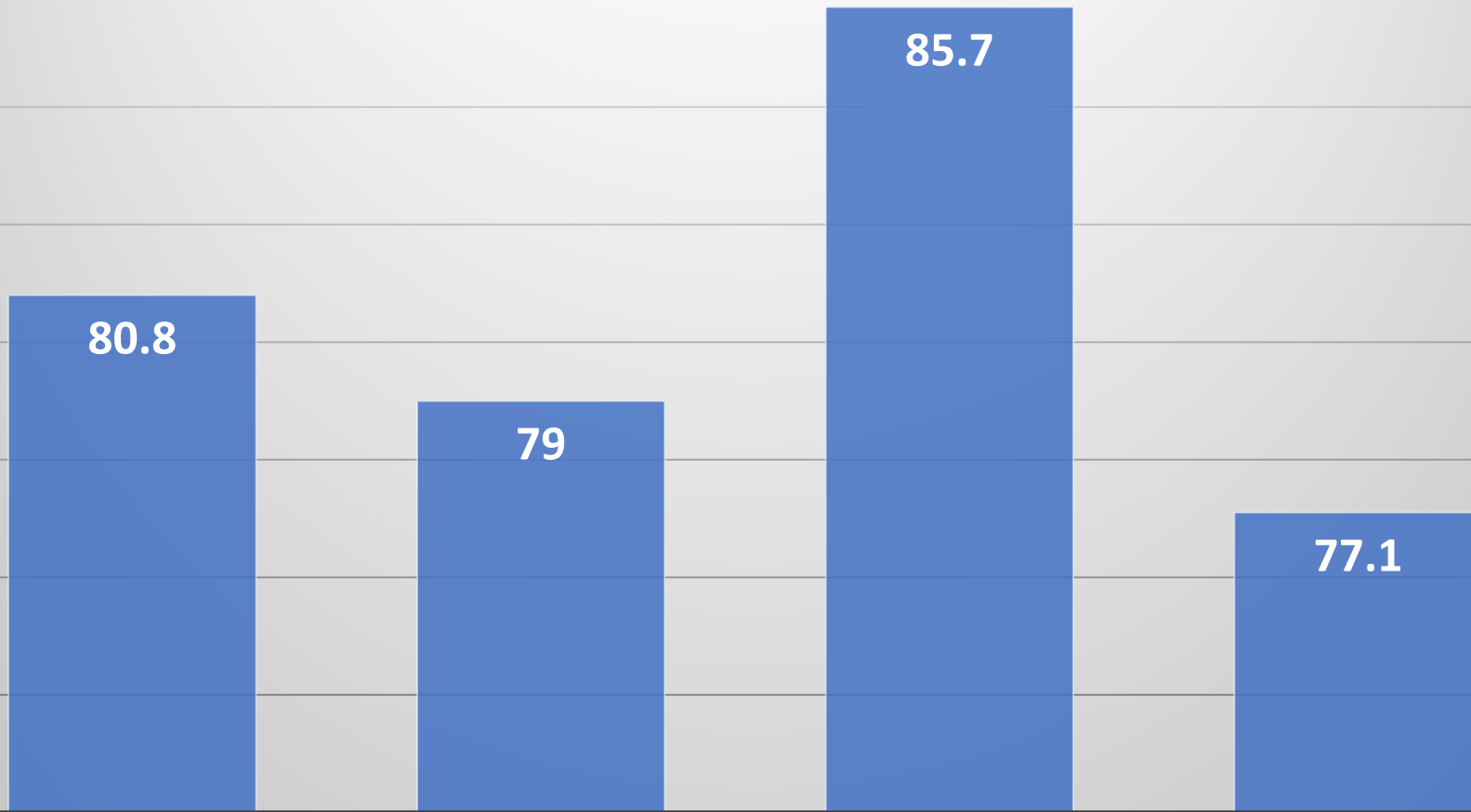
Gender of Awardees

Success – Sociology Spring 2018-2021



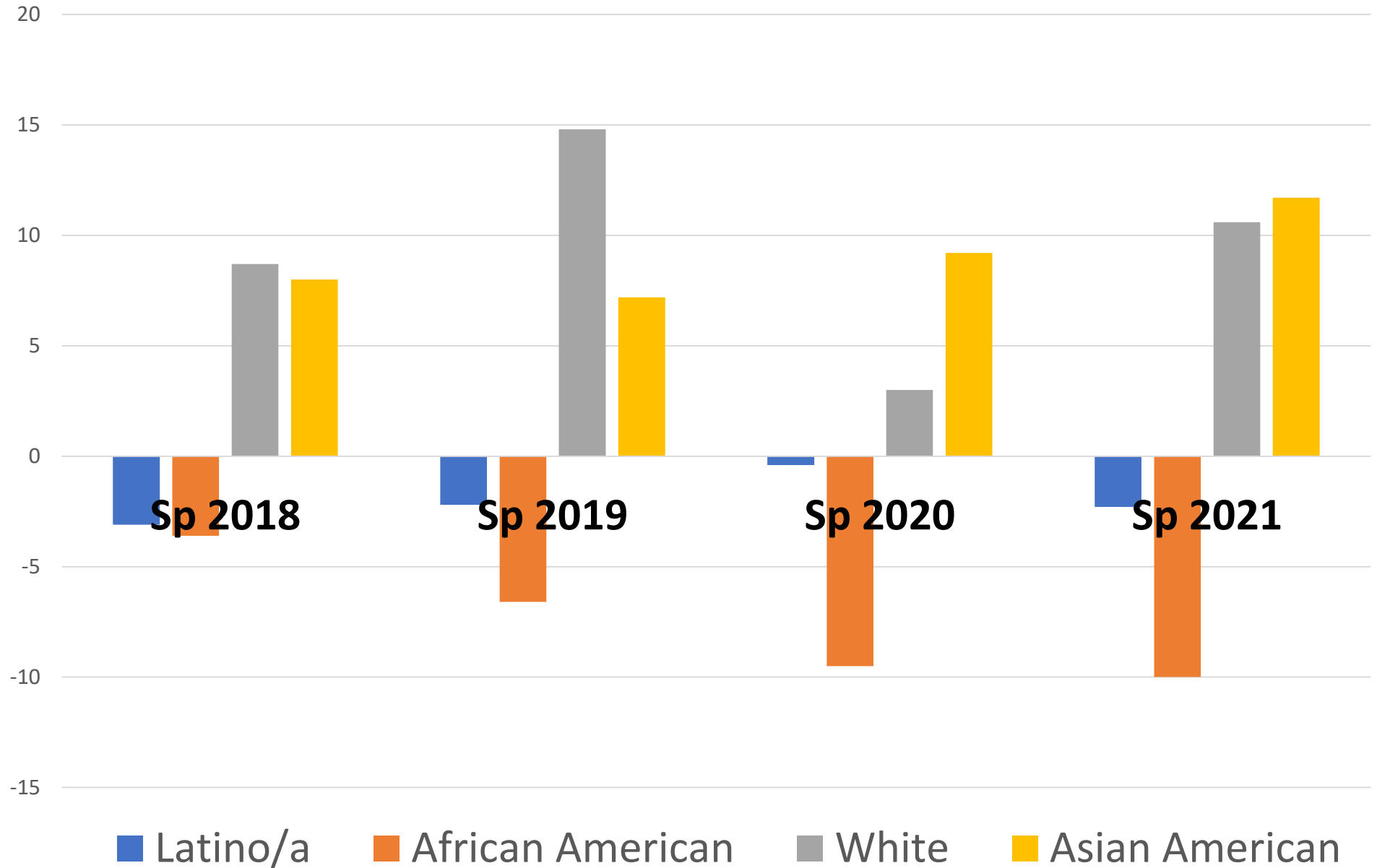
