Online – 31 sections, 88% fill rate

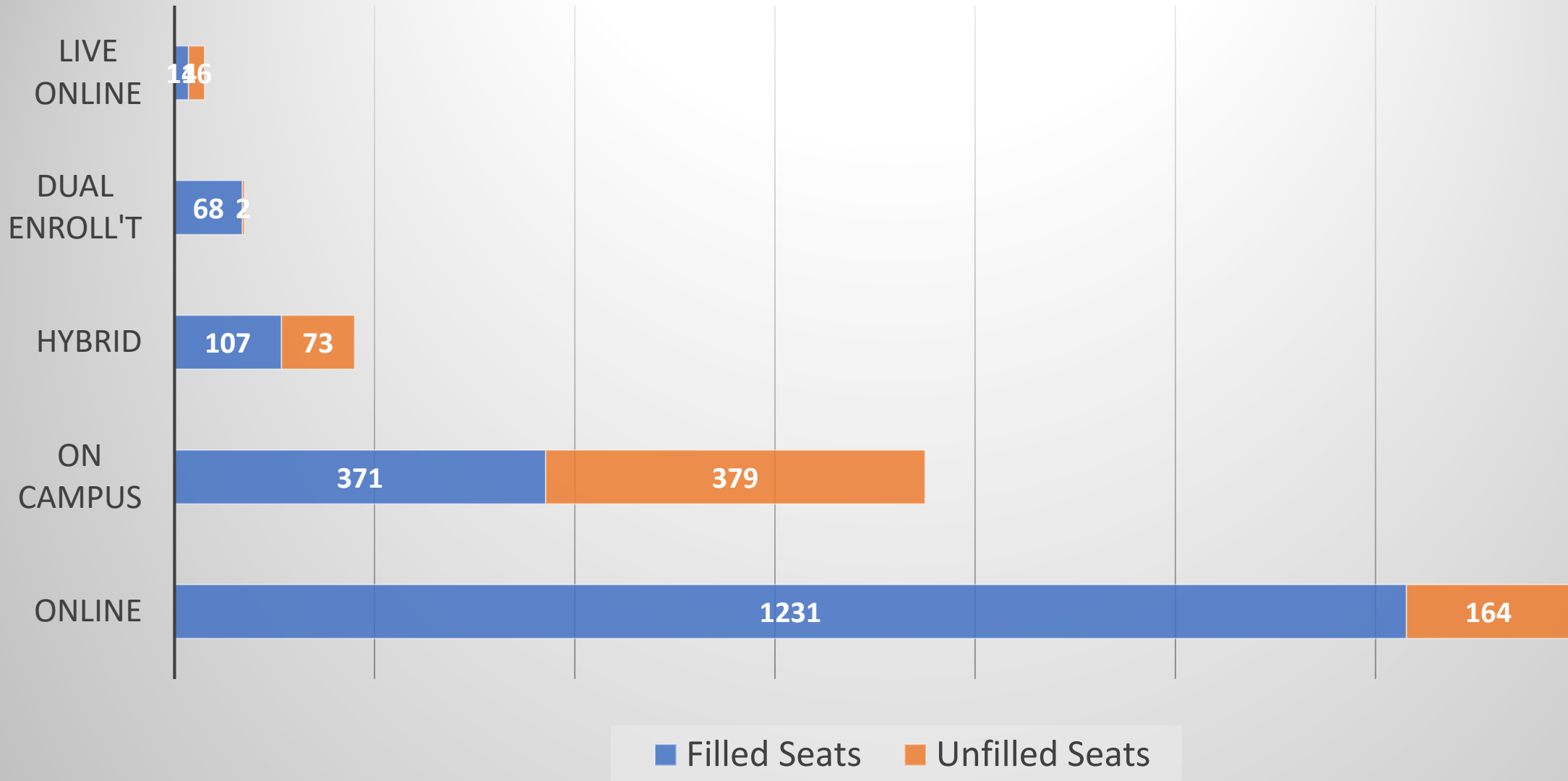
On Campus – 18 sections, 49% fill rate

# Spring 2022 Enrollment – Seats Filled and Unfilled



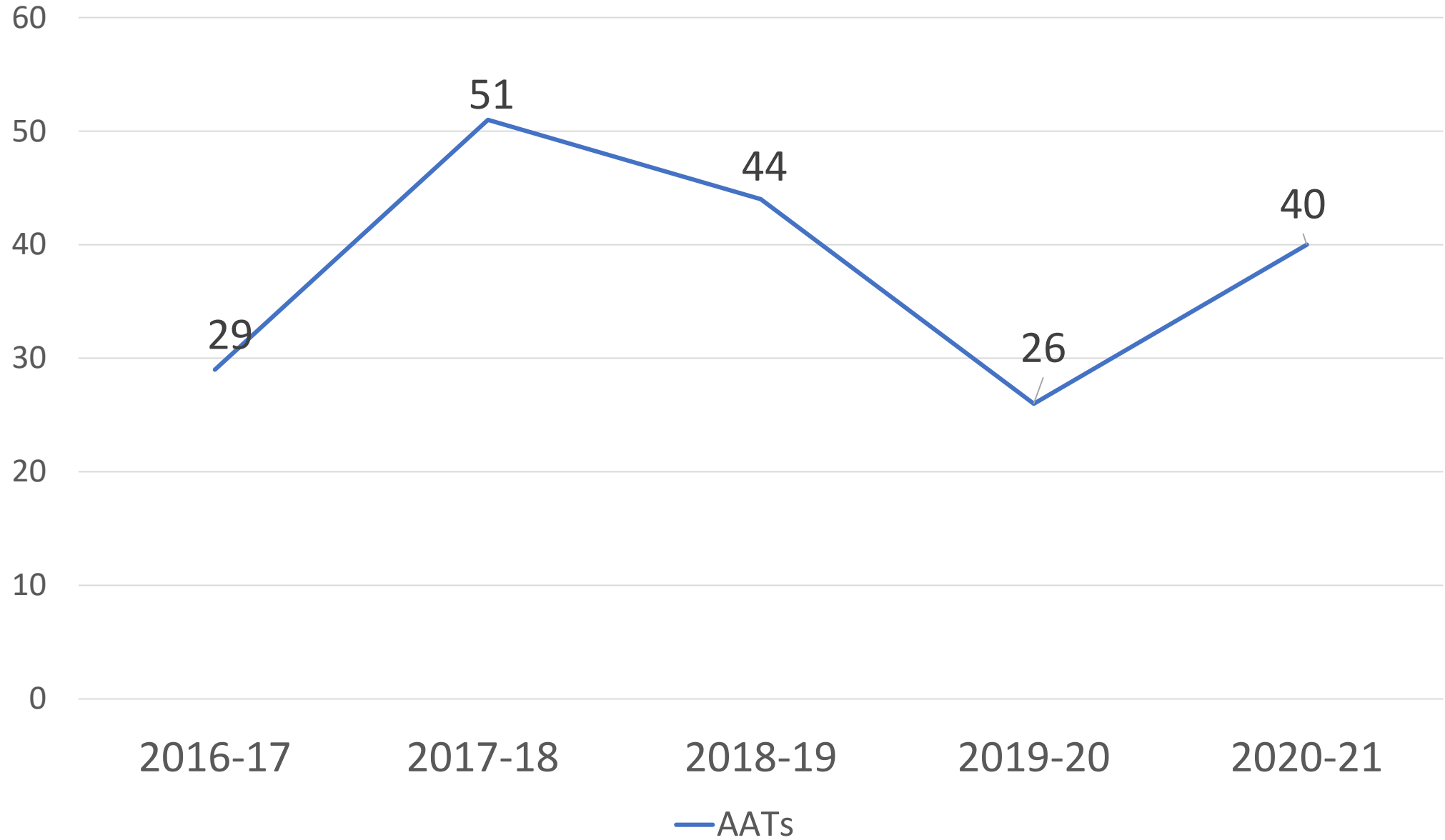

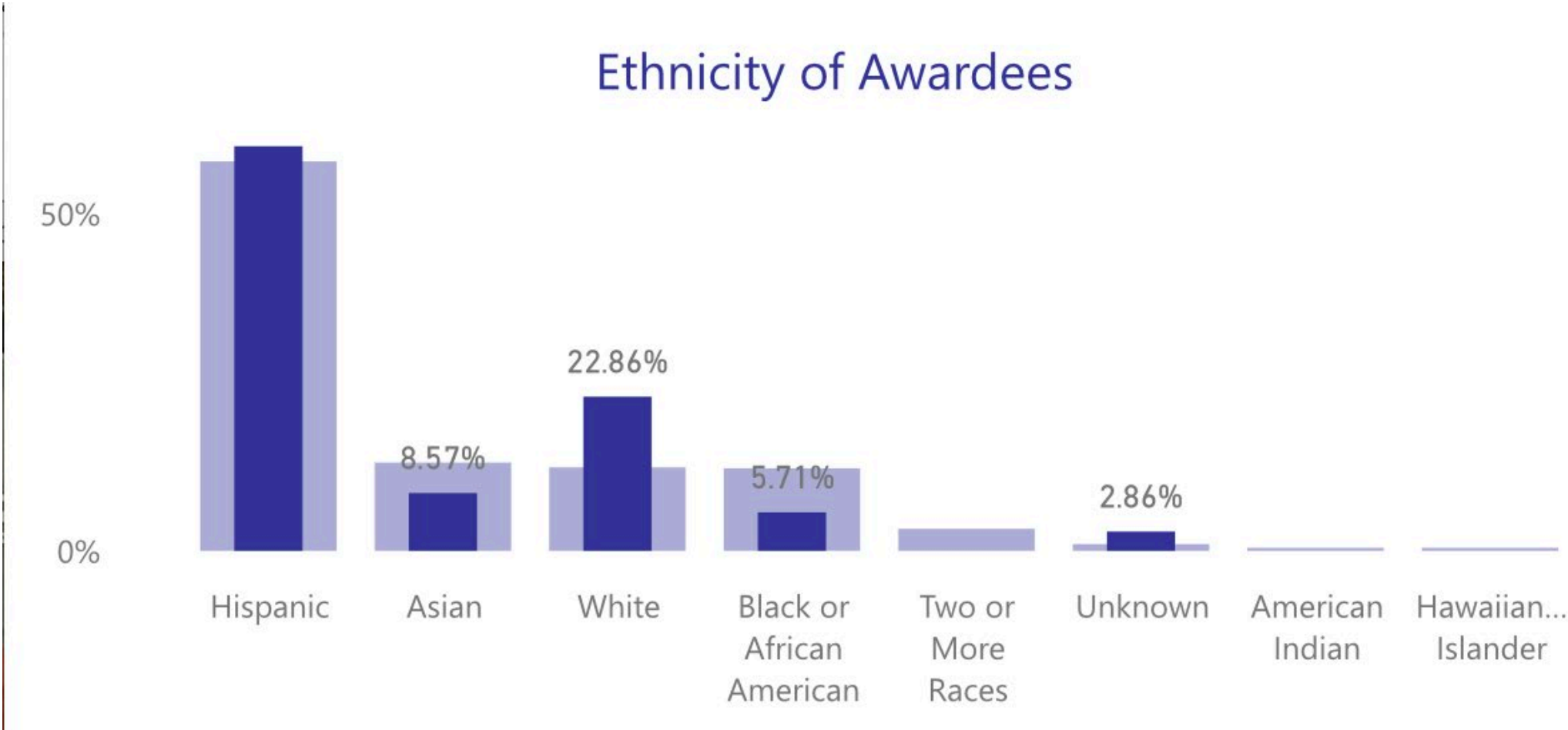

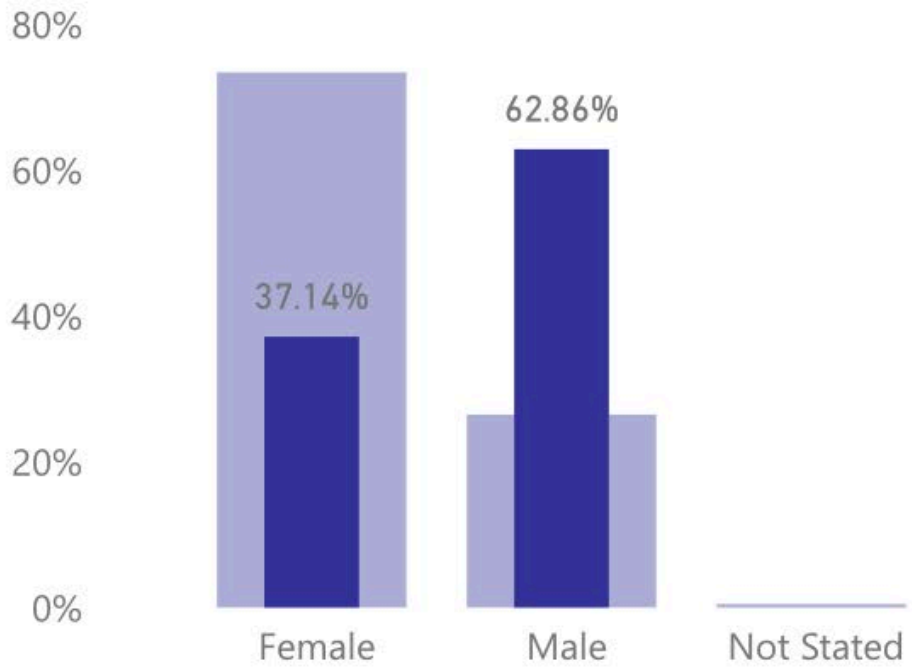
# Ethnicity of 2021 History AAT Awardees (dark blue bar)

(in comparison to BSS AAT awardees – light blue bar)

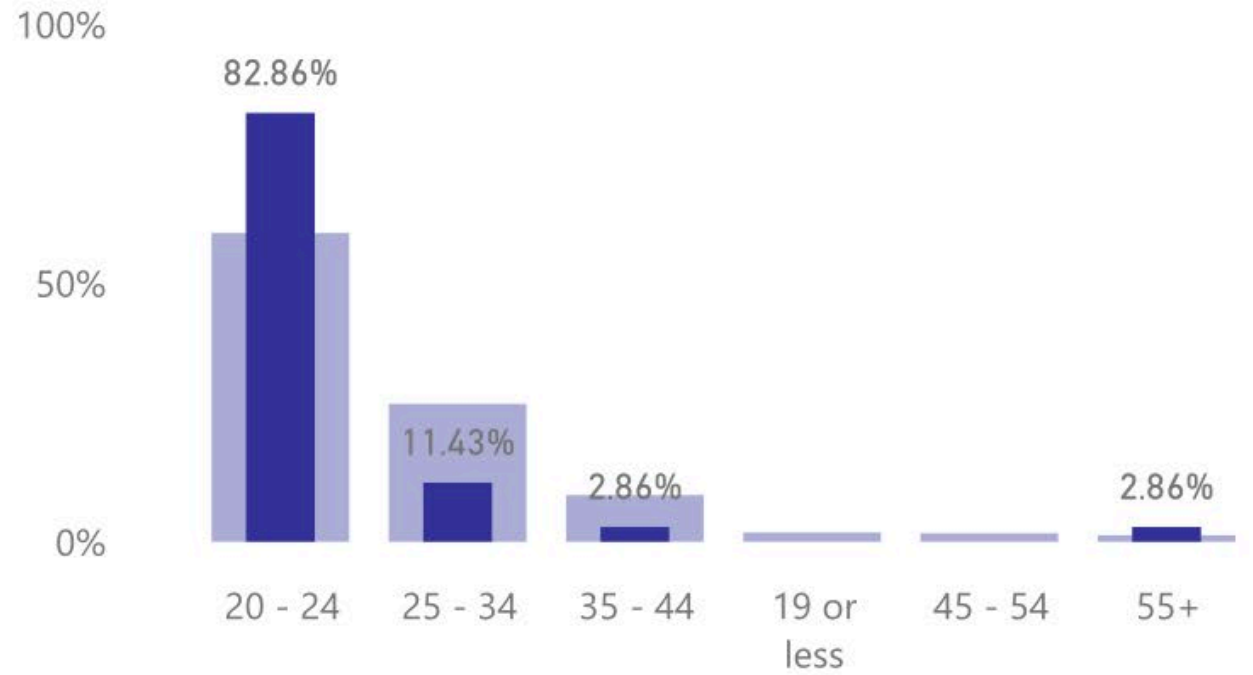




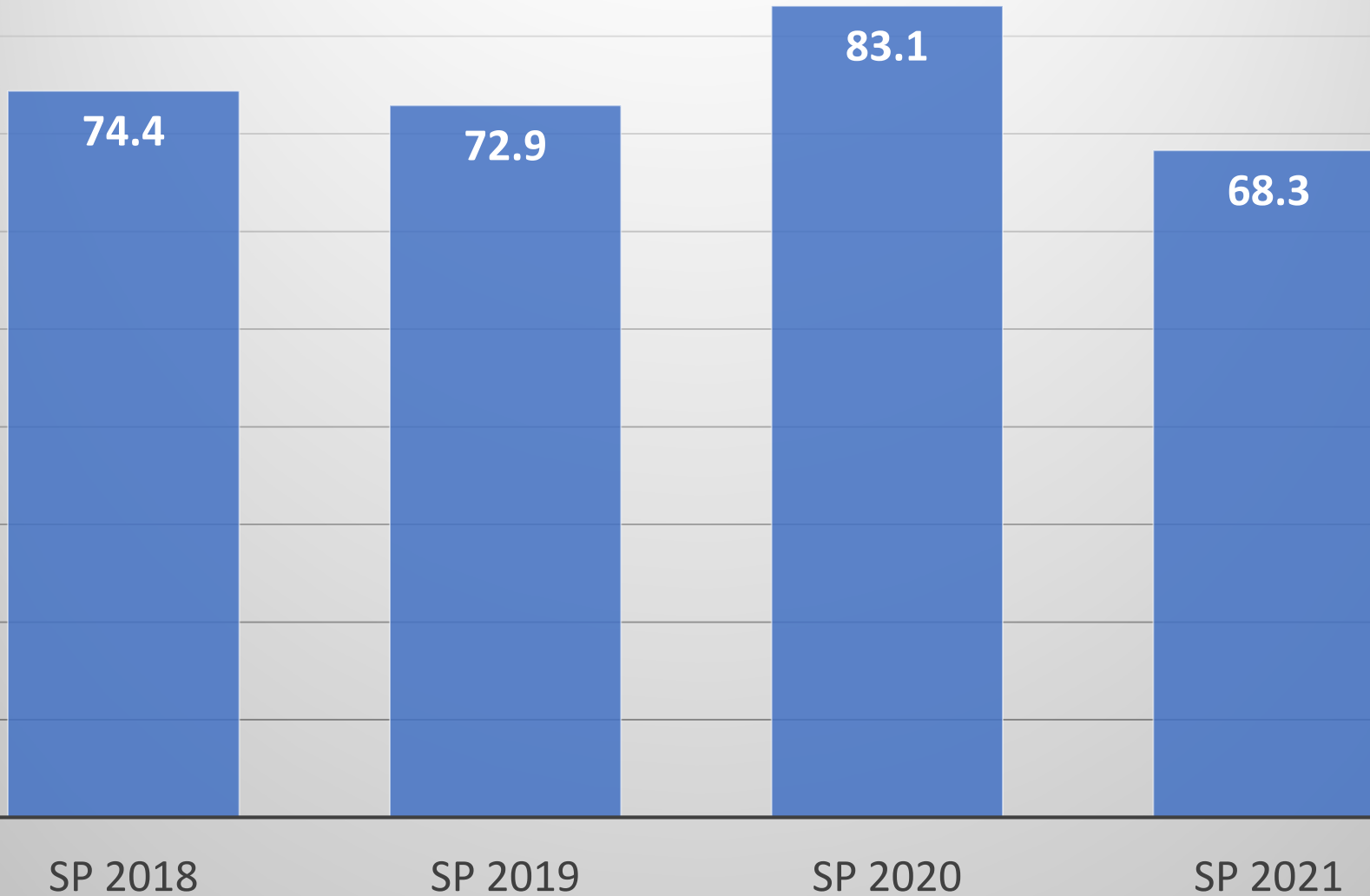
### Gender of Awardees



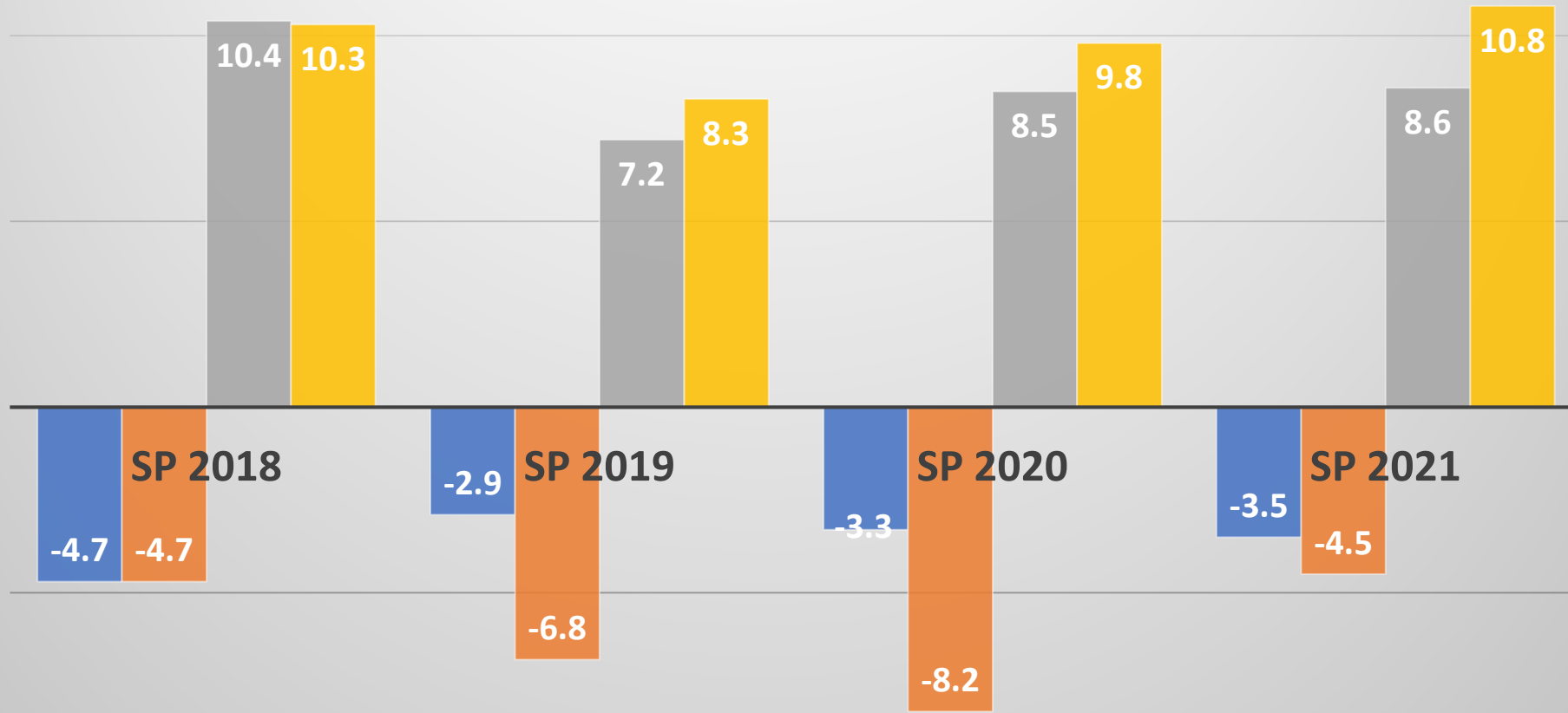
### Age Group of Awardees



## Success – History- Spring 2018-2021

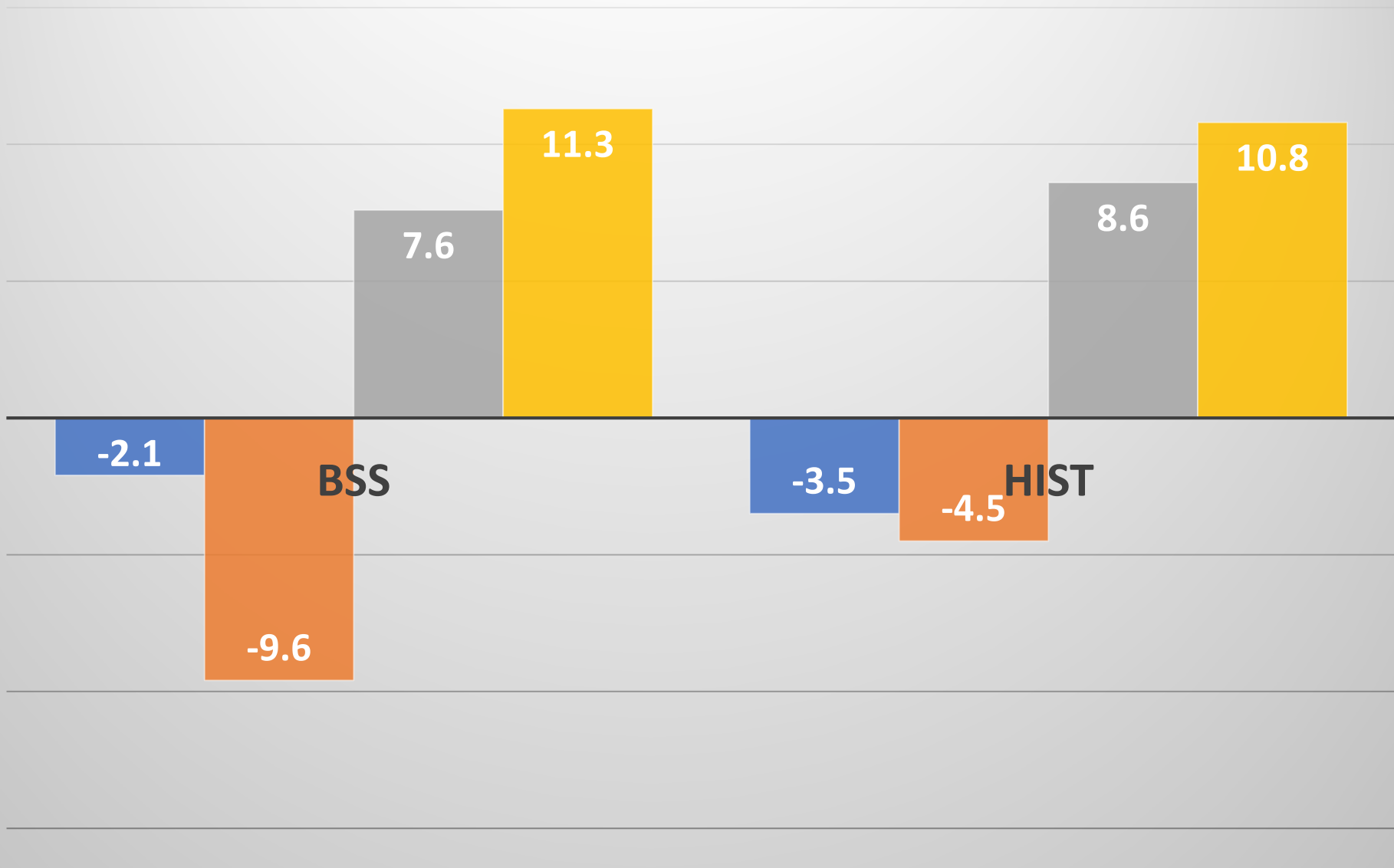


## Success Gaps – History – Spring 2018-2021
