II) Division Business

A. Faculty Hiring

- Full-Time Tenure Track (Childhood Education, Ethnic and Social Justice Studies, Sociology)
- Full-Time Temporary 2023-24 Academic Year (Anthropology, History, Psychology)
- We are in the interview stage with these searches. A couple have headed into offers.
 Most of these should be wrapped up by the end of May.

B. Faculty Evaluations

- About 25 new adjunct, full-time temporary faculty, and probationary faculty are being reviewed.
- Because of the reset of the evaluation schedule due to COVID, we do not have any tenured faculty evaluations this semester. Those will come in a big lump every three years.
- Self-evaluations are due May 12 for 16 week and 1st 8 week courses. Cecelia will send reminders.
- Conferences should be the end of May and beginning of June. Check the schedule for due dates.

C. BSS Success Team

- A new faculty lead is needed for the BSS Success Team. This position comes with special assignment hours. Please let the Dean know if you are interested.
- The Dean is trying to hold these meetings, but they have been conflicting with faculty search meetings and interviews.

D. New Building – Selecting Roommates – More Decisions

- At its last meeting, Division Council determined that faculty offices would be selected according to seniority. The most senior faculty member would select an office and a roommate, and we would proceed accordingly by seniority.
- Bev has obtained an official seniority list from Human Resources. For faculty hired the same year, we will use an online randomizer to determine who will pick first. The Dean will start inviting senior faculty to tour the building if they would like to see the offices before selecting.

- All faculty are moving to the new building and sharing offices, except Communication
 Studies which is joining us in Fall 2023. The plan for Comms Studies all along has been to
 move into the Social Sciences building where it will have offices, hold classes, and house
 Forsenics. About a third of our on-campus classes will ultimately continue to be held in
 the SOCS building.
- Also, our FT temporary faculty and possibly some other related staff (such as a Grant Director and Child Development Permit Specialist may be given shared offices in the SOCS building. Offices will also be held for our new faculty that will be hired this year.
- The Dean requested an exception for our most senior faculty member, Minehiro Inouye. He has served the College for over 50 years and does not want to move offices from the SOCS building. We have an odd number of FT faculty, which means we have one person who will have an office alone.
- Also, as a reminder, faculty will not have assigned classrooms anymore. With so few on campus classes being offered by each individual FT faculty member, this is no longer feasible for scheduling. We are planning to designate classrooms for specific disciplines and to cluster those classrooms together.

III) College Business

A. Strategic Enrollment Management

- For the 2023-24 academic year, the College's overall growth target is 8% (17,041 FTES). This is an ambitious goal, but we are in a rush to build enrollment back up before hold harmless ends and we become funded at our actual enrollment and not an inflated amount.
- Our division showed less enrollment loss during the pandemic than the College as a whole, but our large number of online classes makes growth somewhat easier.
- BSS currently comprises about 20% of College enrollment. That will grow in Fall when we acquire Comms Studies.
- While the College is still building schedules that will maximize the opportunity for students to return to campus, we are also now focusing on fill rates. Moving forward, we will not be able to hold classes that have very low fill rates like we did this Spring.


