Return to Campus -- This may change!

Vaccine mandate

- Faculty, staff and students— Upload vaccination or seek exemption (medical or religious)
- Students Upload by January.
- Winter not permitted on campus without vaccination or exemption
- People with exemptions tested twice a week

Masking


- required indoors
- Not required under the following conditions:
 - When working alone in a private office with the door closed
 - Actively eating or drinking at least 6-feet away from other people
 - Outdoors at a distance of 8 feet or greater
 - Participating outdoors in an Activity class or physical training for Public Safety class
 - Performing in a theatrical production per LA County Guidelines
 - Doing activities that may get the mask wet. Wet masks can make it hard to breathe and do not work as well
 - Wearing an alternate form of required respiratory protection for work

Return to Campus -- This may change!

 Health screening process at kiosks will continue: fill out questionnaire, check in at kiosk, wear bracelet to signify that you've completed the process and are cleared to be on campus

Classrooms

- cleaned regularly, but students and faculty can choose to wipe down spaces after use
- Plexiglass can be requested by faculty BUT not required by LACDPH or OSHA and is not effective in a classroom.
- No food or drink in classrooms
- Students who refuse to wear their mask or do not have wrist band will be refused entry into the classroom
- <u>COVID Training</u>: All faculty and staff will be required to complete a training- about 5 courses totaling approx. 1 hour



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
