# a) Scheduling and Enrollment – Spring 2023 and Fall 2023 Scheduling Priorities (PowerPoint Slides 9-11)

- 1. Discussed student demand and future scheduling.
  - i. Decreased the number of on campus classes due to low fill rates
  - ii. More online sections
  - iii. Flexible schedule to meet student modality needs
  - iv. Avoid scheduling overlapping sections of a course or courses required for a major.
- 2. Discussed how to advertise Hybrid sections to students
  - i. Karen Preciado may be able to create video for students explaining Hybrid sections.

#### b) Success Rates and Gaps (PowerPoint slides 12-14)

1. Success rates have decreased across division.

- i. Discussed the low success rates, and how the pandemic changed learning/teaching.
- 2. Equity gaps have also been expanding. The faculty discussed possible causes.

#### c) New Building - Selecting Roommates - the very final decision!

- 1. The opening for the new building is tentatively scheduled for September 1, 2023.
- 2. It is possible we will begin moving during the Fall 2023 semester. The goal is to avoid disrupting classes.
- 3. Communications will be moving into the SOCS building
- 4. Winter 2024 will be in new building if opening stays on schedule.
- 5. Division council unanimously voted to approve the following office selection procedure:

# Communication Studies – Joining BSS Division Fall 2023

- Communication Studies will be moved to the BSS Division in Fall 2023.
- They are already part of our meta-major, and now they will be part of the Division.
- The division is receiving an Associate Dean and temporary clerical support to help with Forensics Team.
- 8 full-time faculty and 15 part-time faculty.
- COMS has 15 courses and are offering 67 sections this Fall 2022 semester; 25 in Winter 2023; and 84 in Spring 2023.
- COMS 100 Public Speaking is their primary course and comprises half or more of their offerings.
- COMS offers a Communication Studies AAT degree and includes the successful Forensics Team.
- Their classes and offices will be in the SOCS building.
- By comparison, Psychology has 6 full-time faculty, 17 part-time faculty and had 77 sections this Fall.



# Fall 2023 Scheduling Priorities and Factors


<u>Scheduling Priority</u>: Improve fill rates while maximizing student access to general education and major's courses in a strategically selected variety of modalities that reflect enrollment patterns and shifting student demand since the return to campus.


#### **Goals/Factors**

- 1. Strategically schedule fewer on campus sections, so we don't have multiple sections of a course with very low enrollment yet we still maintain a variety of on campus options for students (Spring 2023 on campus fill rate 54%).
- 2. Maintain online sections (Spring 2023 online fill rate 87%).
- 3. Avoid scheduling overlapping sections of a course or courses required for a major.
- 4. Modest demand for on campus and hybrid classes will support the expectation that faculty be teaching on campus 2 days a week in Fall 2023. In Spring 2024, it is possible that will increase to 3 instructional days a week on campus.
- 5. All classes must comply with the block schedule.

## SOCS Construction and Move-in Date


Construction is delayed – the building will possibly be ready to be occupied on September 1, 2023

# SOCS Building (after move to new BSS building)





#### **Future SOCS Building**

# Selection Procedure – BSS and SOCS Offices






# Selection Procedure – BSS Offices
