ASO – The General Assembly traveled to San Jose for the meeting of the state-level ASO. Students are preparing for elections of next year's leadership. Students like the furniture in the new BSSC building. They are glad the floor to ceiling windows in the hallway classrooms have been frosted. Second floor classrooms and some first-floor classrooms still need clocks. The Dean was surprised and will get right on it! **Curriculum**. Irena reported that Kristie Daniel-DiGregorio is stepping down as the DCC Chair and Josh Casper has been nominated to replace her. The committee will be holding the official election at its next meeting. New courses include Asian, Pacific Islander, and Desi American Studies; Service Learning for Social Problems; Islamic Art and Visual Culture; Introduction to Inductive Logic and Probability Theory; and Honors Language and Culture.
