I) Enrollment Issues: Fraud, No Shows, and Certifying Rosters

	1 st day of Spring	After census	Change
Spring 2023	86%	87%	+1%
Spring 2024	90%	86%	-4%
Spring 2025	95%	84%	-11%

The large drop in fill rates after census in Spring 2025 is likely due to the extensive fraud. Faculty struggled in figuring out who was real and who was fraudulent. They were inundated with requests to add, many of which seemed fraudulent.

II) Enrollment and Annualized Schedule

- HIST - Fall 2024 – 63 sections, 93% fill rate - 65% of sections offered online
- HIST - Fall 2025 – 62 sections - 47% of sections planned online

The College is moving towards 60% on-campus and 40% online sections. BSS has a current goal of 50/50%. Counselors are reporting more demand for on-campus sections.
