





PHILOSOPHY AAT DEGREES 2018-19




Dark blue: Philosophy

Light blue: ECC


Success Rates (ECC, BSS, Philosophy) – Spring 2017-19




Retention (ECC, BSS, Philosophy) – Spring 2017-18




Disaggregated Success Spring 2019 – ECC, BSS, Philosophy
