### OER/ZTC Data

- Yara Farah discussed the new data from Mary McMillan from the Spring faculty textbook survey.
- Yara will be making spreadsheets from the new data once we have outcome data from IRP for Spring 2022. Then we can compare it to data from previous semesters.

### Warrior Welcome Day Planning

- The team brainstormed ideas for the Warrior Welcome Day event scheduled to take place on Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. The three main ideas the team settled on were:
  - Social Science 101 – Have a faculty member discuss Social Science 101, why it’s a good way to get started in the Meta Major, it’s transferability, and career planning value.
  - OER/ZTC – Have a faculty member discuss OER/ZTC, and show students how to access and use the filters in the online course schedule to find classes that are OER/ZTC.
  - Student Clubs and Activities – Invite representatives from a couple of clubs, or possibly the forensics team, to talk about being involved in student clubs and other activities like speech and debate.
- The team also discussed where to hold the “tour.” It was decided that we should take the students to at least two, maybe three different classrooms for the different parts of the tour, while staying close to Marsee Auditorium, where the main event is being held.
- Finally, the team discussed having faculty members make short “elevator pitch” videos of 30 seconds or so in length to “sell” students on their major. Marketing and Communications can edit the videos together for the team.
