ID.ME VERIFICATION

ID.me is available to El Camino College applicants to verify and protect their identity.

Verification usually takes 5-10 minutes and requires you to submit identity documentation.

Read the provided info, then choose an option:

- Verify with ID.me select this option to create an ID.me account and proceed with verification.
- What if I can't verify my identity with ID.me? – select this option to decline ID.me and proceed to My Applications







CCC Students Expected to Verify Their Identity with ID.me

The California Community Colleges (CCC) now use ID.me to help keep your identity safe and make it easier to apply to college and get financial aid.

Why Do I Need to Verify My Identity?

- Verifying your identity helps protect against someone else stealing it to apply for college or financial aid.
- If you skip ID.me verification, your college application may be put on hold until you verify who you are.
- · Identity verification is required before you can get your financial aid.

What to expect:

- 1 Redirecting you to the ID.me website
- 2 Verifying your identity with primary or secondary documents
- 3 Returning you to your community college application









Click the **Start a New Application** button to begin your application for admission.

Social Security Number


Just Remember...

Providing a social security number or taxpayer identification number is not required with respect to non-U.S. resident students (whether documented or undocumented), students taking noncredit courses, students whose qualified tuition and related expenses are waived or paid with scholarships or paid by an institutional third party including an employer or government agency. (26 C.F.R. § 1.6050S-1.) A SSN or TIN/iTIN is not required when IRS reporting is not required.

- You will receive an email from El Camino College Admissions & Records with your application
 Confirmation Number (8 digits, no letters)
- K-12 applicants will receive an additional email from El Camino College with information about
 Dual Enrollment

After 1-3 Business Days (excludes weekends and holidays)

- You will receive a Welcome Email from El Camino College with your 7-digit El Camino College
 Student ID Number and MyECC username and initial password
 - Click the link to sign into <u>MyECC</u>, El Camino's online student portal. If you did not provide a SSN/TIN, you will need to complete a form to learn your 4-digit initial password.
 - You will be prompted to create a new password the first time you sign in. Keep your MyECC username and password in a safe place.
 - Access your @elcamino.edu email address in MyECC or at outlook.com/elcamino.edu

MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

NEXT STEPS (NEW COLLEGE STUDENTS)

Financial Aid

Need help paying for college? Apply for financial aid by completing the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> (<u>FAFSA</u>) or the <u>California Dream Act Application (CADAA</u>) online. (The school code for ECC is 001197)

Assessment

Complete the **English and Mathematics Placement Survey** in <u>MyECC</u> (link available the **New STUDENT – START HERE** card). After you receive your placement, you can register for English/math courses. Chemistry Placement Tests are also offered by the <u>Warrior Welcome Center</u> (sign up online).

Orientation

Familiarize yourself with El Camino College and its resources. The <u>Warrior Welcome Center</u> offers online and inperson New Student Orientations throughout the year.

Educational Planning

Meet with an El Camino College counselor to complete an Educational Plan identifying what classes to take to achieve your educational goals. To schedule a counseling appointment, go to the <u>Counseling Appointments</u> page (requires MyECC username and password). For questions, contact the <u>Academic Counseling Office</u>.


Register for classes using <u>MyECC</u>. On the student dashboard, there is a **REGISTER FOR CLASSES** card with options to:


