Why Dual Enrollment?

- A. **Get ahead** Earn high school and college credit at the same time, one semester usually equals one year
- **B.** Save time Earn a college degree faster by starting early
- **C. Save money** Enrollment fees are waived!
- D. Build confidence Experience and succeed in college-level courses, become familiar with college admission and registration processes
- **E. Stand out** on university/college applications
- F. Follow a passion or interest
- G. Explore careers and majors

Two Types of Dual Enrollment

Dual Enrollment in El Camino College Classes

- Traditional college classes (on-campus and online)
- Open to public, students **register themselves** to save their seat
- K-12 students complete all Steps for Dual Enrollment and purchase required textbooks/materials

Dual Enrollment in High School Partnership Classes

- Dual Enrollment, Career Pathways, and Early College
- Not open to public, just for students at local high school/district
- K-12 students complete Steps 1-2 only, are **manually registered** by ECC staff, high school provides textbooks/materials

Two Types of Dual Enrollment

For both types

- Enrollment fees (and other misc. fees) are waived!
- Classes count for college credit (on college transcript) and high school credit (as determined by high school)
- **Same steps** (but Steps 3-4 done for students in Partnership Classes)

High School Partnership Classes

We also offer classes at 20 local high school campuses

Winter 2023 Term

5-Week Session

- Thursday, January 5, to Tuesday, February 7
- Same course content as 16-week semester, just accelerated
- Most classes meet 5 days per week (Monday-Friday) for extended meetings (2-4 hours)
- Dual Enrollment limited to 1 course

Spring 2023 Term

16-Week Semester

- Saturday, February 11, to Friday, June 9
- Weekday classes begin week of Monday, February 13
- Most classes meet twice a week (Mon/Wed or Tues/Thur)
- Spring Recess is April 8-14
- Some 8-Week Classes
 - First 8-Week Session February 11 to April 7
 - Second 8-Week Session ("Mid-Term Classes") start April 15

AJ 100 - Introduction to Administration of Justice

3 units **3 hours lecture Recommended Preparation: ENGLA** Credit, degree applicable Transfer CSU, UC

This course introduces students to the characteristics of the criminal justice system in the United States. Focus is placed on examining crime measurement, theoretical explanations of crime, responses to crime, components of the system, and current challenges to the system. The course examines the evolution of the principles and approaches utilized by the justice system and the evolving forces which have shaped those principles and approaches. Although justice structure and process are examined in a cross context, emphasis is placed on the United States justice system, particularly the structure and function of police, courts, and corrections. Students are introduced to the origins and development of criminal law, legal process, sentencing, and incarceration policies.

Need to apply again?

- Students need to submit a new application for admission if they do not register **for consecutive fall and spring terms**
 - Sign into existing OpenCCC account
 - Re-activate same El Camino student account
- Students also need to apply again in order to attend El Camino as a First-Time College Student after high school
 - Sign into existing OpenCCC account
 - Update same El Camino student account

Do not create another OpenCCC Account!

- Can result in multiple El Camino student accounts
- Results in a hold across all accounts, can take weeks to resolve

Search for Classes

- Same as Online Searchable
 Schedule
- Use to add sections to your "Schedule" (not yet registered!)
- Can add many sections to visualize meeting days/times

Register for Classes

 Use buttons to **Register** or Waitlist the sections you've added to your Schedule



- **Registration Appointment** is simply the earliest date/time you can register for classes
 - K-12 students will receive Winter Registration Appointments for a time on Wednesday, November 23
 - K-12 students will receive Spring Registration Appointments for a time on **Friday, December 9**

Error Messages

- "As a high school student, you do not have a permission to take this course" = Dual Enrollment Form not processed yet or this course was not listed on your form
- "This is not your scheduled appointment" = It is before your Registration Appointment date/time
- "Registration not allowed for UG courses without academic program" = Possible error on your student account, *let us know!*
- "The following required prerequisite for course _____ is not started" = Prerequisite not yet cleared in our system

Waitlist Classes

- After class section reaches capacity...
 - Can no longer register
 - Instead join waitlist (usually 10 students)
- If seats become available **before term begins**, then waitlisted students are moved onto roster in waitlist order
- After term begins, only way to enroll in a class is with an Add Code provided by the instructor
- K-12 students must have a Dual Enrollment Form on file for the term and have cleared any course Prerequisites

Add Classes

- On-Campus at El Camino College? Show up to first class meeting to ask for an Add Code
- Online or Hybrid? Email instructor to ask for an Add Code
 - Find email addresses using <u>Faculty & Staff Directory</u> or Search for Classes tool in MyECC
 - Make sure to include the Section Number of the class you are wanting to add
- Identify if you are on the waitlist (priority for adds)
- Add Codes are provided at the instructor's discretion
- Students must use Add Code in MyECC before the Last Day to Add. K-12 students must have a Dual Enrollment Form on file and have cleared any Prerequisites

- Canvas Login Page will direct you to sign in using MyECC

- Order online at Transcripts Webpage
- Uses Parchment vendor to send secure transcripts directly to desired institution(s)
 - Can send to your high school or universities/colleges
 - If your high school requires Official Transcripts, please confirm with them PDF vs. hard copy and the email or physical address where transcripts need to be sent
 - First two transcript copies are free, \$6 per transcript after that
