Acting classes and Stage Lighting have been difficult and the program is looking forward to returning to in person instruction. 2 productions are scheduled for Fall (“Psycho Beach Party” and “Shop Around the Corner”) Hoping for a limited audience in Fall.
 - ✓ CFA—Busy with plays and spending end of the semester funds. A production planning meeting is scheduled for June 3rd @ 1pm to go over performances for fall.
 - ✓ Art—Virtual student show is forthcoming at the end of the semester. Teaching online is going well and students are getting used to the format and the quality of work is impressive.
 - ✓ Music—Half a dozen majors are now practicing in our music rooms on campus. Dane is retiring with Joanna and David Moyer splitting those responsibilities. 9 students submitted videos for scholarships. Each will receive 1-2K.
 - ✓ Film—Not much to report. Had 5-8 students accepted to 4 years colleges (CSULB, CSUDH) Acclimating to the online environment. It’s different but the quality of work is exciting.

- ✓ Photo—2 events coming up. Master Class Series is continuing at specified times and during classes. These classes have had a positive impact on students and enrollment remains steady. S. Bay Camera Club has been around for 70 years and D. Rowan will be giving a presentation on History of Photography on May 24th.
