B. Proposals Due to the College Curriculum Committee

1. May 7th – Submit Corrected COR's to CCC
 - a. Music class hours and minutes need to be corrected. J. Minei will contact P. Schulz.
2. May 11th – Summer 2020 DE Addenda
 - a. Summer classes that did not currently have DE approval need to be reviewed on the team site and voted on.
 - b. L. Leach will review for COMS.
 - c. W. Cox asked the committee to review the COR's and DE addendums on the Team Site and vote or make any changes.
3. May 26th – Fall 2020 DE Addenda/Curriculum Clean-up Due Date
 - a. We are hoping to offer as many courses as possible online then may be able to schedule 2nd 8-week courses online or on campus. More information this will be discussed in department meetings.

- b. We need to review courses that are not set-up or approved as online or hybrid.
- c. We need to follow-up with Art. W. Cox will send Art History courses to I. Mori to review.
- d. W. Cox looked into the Directing class but we cannot have an audition class the way R. Scarlata wanted it.
- e. The Chancellor's office is looking at prerequisites. We may have to provide data that exists. Prerequisites are necessary for some classes.

II. DISCUSSION/ACTIONS

A. CCC Update – J. Minei

- 1. COMS 180, IGETC Area 2 & CSU area B4; COMS 270, CSU area D have been approved.
- 2. Music 101 was rejected again for the AA-T. The concern is the AA-T will count for more points.

III. OTHER

- A. 1st 8-weeks of Fall, 2020 will be online/remote. We are not sure yet about the 2nd 8-week courses at this time.
- B. We are trying to get all courses that can be taught online DE Certified. If not online by Fall, they will have to submit a request to the Chancellors Office to appeal for an exception.
- C. We strongly recommend all faculty who will be teaching in Fall to get DE Certified. Faculty should contact Moses Wolfstein to get DE Certified.
- D. B. Price reviewed the Fall, 2020 schedule by department. The spreadsheet includes recommendations by faculty for planning for teaching classes during COVID-19 with social distancing requirements.

- E. B. Price explained how hybrid courses may work. It is the most flexible. Classes could move to face to face but it is possible this may not happen for Fall, 2020. If a class is totally dependent on face to face instruction, we may not offer as a 16-week class.
