- 2. CLP Focus Groups:** J. Pon-Ishikawa provided update:  
CLP (Career Ladders Project) Focus groups were completed. Focus groups were concentrated from Puente, Project Success, KEAS, FYE, Veterans and Non-Program Students. Some program students were also involved with a secondary support group. Received some feedback from night students, but was minimally represented. Overall students in the focus groups agreed the programs were a benefit and gave them an advantage in adapting to college, obtaining classes and knowing their educational plans.
- 3. Meta-Major Data:** J. Simon provided update:  
Gave preview of initial Meta-Major data results. Eight categories were created from data results. Strong agreement for French, Japanese, Spanish, Sign Language/Interpreter Training, ESL and English to be in a Meta-Major together. Strong agreement for Sociology and Psychology to be together. Strong agreement for Geology, Astronomy, Chemistry, Biology, General Science, Physical Science and Physics. Strong agreement for Manufacturing Technology, MTT, ACRP, ACR, Auto Tech., Welding and Construction Technology. Strong agreement for Respiratory Care and Nursing. Strong agreement for Administration of Justice and Paralegal. Strong agreement for Real Estate, Business and Economics. Meta-Majors to still be finalized, along with Meta-Major category names.
