

Minutes of Humanities DCC Meeting, 9/15/16, 1-2pm

Here are the courses and a summary of the changes discussed:

CHIN 1: Independent study hours will change to 7, skills matching will eliminate English 84, which is not a recommended preparation.

ESL 02C: Spelling/grammar corrected in typical assignment, a dash added to *5-minute conversation*, will add ESL 03C objectives to skills matching. ESL 03C is a co-requisite, and Chelsea will ask Allison Carr or Tom Lew how to handle co-requisites and skills matching. Independent study hours will change to 5.

ESL 02D: See issue with co-requisite skills matching above for ESL 02C. The college-level critical thinking assignment #1 will be rephrased.

ESL 52A: There was a minor change in the outline of subject matter; independent study hours will change to 7.

ESL 52B: There was a minor change in the outline of subject matter; in critical thinking assignment, the film mentioned will change to a book "Animal Farm" since it is a reading class.

ESL 52C: Since outline of subject matter came up 5 hours short, 5 hours will be added to vocabulary building. Phrasing about "world wide web" was removed from college-level critical thinking assignment.

The next project for the semester will be cross-listing Academic Strategies courses with English courses.
