School Business:

- **No Show Reports** this is due this Friday 9/7; do them early if possible; once a week Friday classes, okay to wait until 9/7.

- The SENSE survey: national survey conducted every 2 years, by the institutional research department, to study students' response to college. It is conducted in certain assigned classes and takes 50 minutes of class time. If one of your classes was assigned, you can opt-out (especially since it is a big time commitment), but consider trying to fit it in as the data is beneficial.

Discussion Items

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- Spring Scheduling:
 - o *AB705 related changes*: AB705 'soft opening' in Spring is delaying things (full compliance is needed by Fall 2019, so Spring is the time to work out the kinks); it will also impact what is offered—in general no RWA classes will be offered and expect more 1A and 1AS classes (specifically Spring will have: 13 Reading classes, 8 RWE, 4 Eng B, 8 Eng A, 12 Eng 1AS)
 - o Requests will go out next week
 - No rollover; different preference request form
 - o Everyone must teach at least one English 1A
 - o 1A/1AS (How courses will be assigned): students with a GPA of 2.6 or higher will be placed into Eng 1A; students with lower or unknown GPAs will speak to counselors and be encouraged to take Eng 1AS, or a remedial course

What is AB705? In a nutshell, it requires that a community college district or college maximize the probability that a student will enter and complete transfer-level coursework in English and math within a one year timeframe; basically we can't compel students to take remedial courses.

- O Due to these changes, classroom requests cannot be honored; time slots may change
- o Winter schedule will most likely stay the same (for now)
 - CAP and CADE: consider going to a CAP or CADE conference—they have great training on how to adjust teaching styles in the wake of AB705; one day and three day conferences are available and you can get reimbursed
