SLO REPORT SAMPLES

A question Ms. Bucher often gets is how to set the success rate target. Mr. Georgevich suggested reviewing the success rate of the previous SLO assessments and using that as a starting point, increase it slightly.

The results section should include information on sample size, as well as the number of students, their scores and percentages, an analysis and interpretation of the results, and the participating faculty.

The action plan needs to be measurable.

DEAN'S REMARKS

Ms. Sims recommended that the SLO questions be determined a semester prior to the course review so faculty can be notified at the beginning of the assessment semester.
