1. Introduction to STEM- Associate dean, G. Valle mentioned that they will be meeting this Friday. The update is that they will be looking into if HDEV 101 or 105 will be better. HDEV 101 deals with soft skills, time management and study skills, 105 is exploration. Both together is what the course was intended to be, but will be too much. G. Valle mentioned that maybe there will be not enough time on Friday to talk about creating a new human development course. The intent is to offer this course in the upcoming fall 2021.

Update on MATH 115 and 116 units approval

E. Ambrosio mentioned that these courses were could have been submitted and approved in spring 2020 but the course of outline of record is not reflecting that. These courses were sent to CCC and were approved, but E. Ambrosio will confirm and will do a follow up with Lavonne Plum. E. Ambrosio will inform Dr. Lemons of this update.
