Update on Math 210

Currently waiting to be approved or disapproved by Dr. Shankweiler. J. Sims mentioned that there are no current updates. Greg Fry suggested to go with the old one if not approved. Math 210 Discrete Mathematics is 4 units at the moment but it is a loaded class and we are asking for an increase of 1 unit. It currently does not meet the CID. It is currently waiting to be approved by the Vice President, as we do not want to affect other programs around campus if units are increased explained J. Sims.

Update on Computer Science 40 and Engineering 9

D. Eldanaf mentioned that J. Young sent the documents for computer science 40 and Engineering 9. After reviewing other schools statics courses that are 3 units, it was decided to take out one of the topics from Engineering 9. E. Ambrosio mentioned that the only update for computer science 40 is the textbook. No changes on objective or course outline, but he will confirm with Satish Singhal.

Math 110, 111, 23.

D. Eldanaf is waiting on Susie Tummers-Stocum for the review on math 110. Math 111 is being inactivated and was sent to Lavonne Plum to remove. There are minimal changes to math 23 because of AB705.

Math 37 and 67

Due this current semester, Fall 2018. Each one of these classes has a pending and an active proposal in CurricUNET. D. Eldanaf is still waiting to hear back from Lars Kjeseth as to which will be used for the review.

Math 80

Reviewed last semester and has been completed.

Sims will send an email that goes out to all of the faculty recommending what Sue Bickford suggested and this can be forwarded it to the chairs of the committees. J. Sims and S. Bickford will work on this together. B. Mitchell gave an update on Math 130S and Math 150S. He mentioned that for math 150, the prerequisite skills needed are not all the same as for the other support courses. Committee chairs will assign leads for the corequisites.
