

# **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To participate, students must:

- · Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher\*
- Have completed Algebra II, Geometry, and preferably Pre-Calculus
- Have less than six college units completed
- Agree to follow the prescribed course pathway and participate in all program activities

\* Students with a GPA below a 3.0 must submit a one-page statement with their application explaining the reason(s) for their current GPA and a plan for maintaining a 3.0 in the CS Pathway program.
