1. ALC Report—Jim Noyes

- Biology—Spring all sections assessed on scientific method. Biology 8, 11 and 12 will be done in fall, they are not taught in the spring.

- Earth Science—no assessments in spring.
- Compton—is on its own timeline. Wanda Morris will be the new division dean and the transition will occur over the summer. Astronomy and Physics is getting combined into one assessment. There will be a new Compton representative in the fall, Dr. Keig is retiring.
