#### 2. Professional and Personal Growth Assessment Timeline

A list of faculty that will be participating is available. There are 42 sections – 15 from CEC; 27 from ECC. There will be approximately 1,200 students involved. A suggestion during the flex day workshop was to include more student participants in the survey. K. Laureano will send an email to faculty who are selected to survey their students. Deans and facilitators will be copied on the email. Faculty will be emailed the 5<sup>th</sup> week of the semester and the survey will be sent out during the 6<sup>th</sup> week. Surveys should be returned in two weeks. C. Subramaniam and D. Vakil will send out an email to CEC faculty.

# 3. Community Collaboration Core Competency

Target courses that are map 4 under this core competency. Recruit faculty to help with decisions, assessment, and feedback.
