Pathway # 1 – CSU Admissions Requirements

- ❖ 60 CSU transferable units by the end of Spring 2024
- 30 units from general education (GE), completed with a "C" or better
- Golden 4 courses on CSU-GE by the end of Spring 2024, completed with a "C" or better
 - 1) English 1A
 - 2) Critical Thinking (English 1C or Coms 120 or Phil 105 or Phil 106 or Psy 103 or BUS 108 (formerly BUS 28 -effective fall 2019)
 - 3) Oral Communication (COMS 100 or 120 or 130 or 140 or BUS 109 (formerly BUS 29 effective fall 2020; same as SUPVN 27)
 - 4) Transfer Level Math (100 level or higher) or BUS 115 (formerly 15 effective fall 2018 or later) or BUS 117 (formerly 17 effective fall 2018 or later) or COMS 180 or CSCI 7 or 8 or Psych 109A or Soc 109A
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Some CSU campuses require major prep courses for admission

*CSULA's Psychology major requires the AA-T for admission.

*There may be some additional majors at other CSU's that may require the AA-T/AS-T for admission.

Benefits

- > Meet major prep requirements for all CSU's that offer "deemed similar" degree.
- .1 CSU transferable GPA increase when applying to an impacted CSU campus.
- Guarantees admission to a <u>non-impacted</u> CSU campus.
- Ensures completion of bachelor's degree at university within 60 units or less.

Steps Required for AA-T/AS-T Process:

- 1) Indicate AA/AS-T status in the "Extended Profile" section of the CSU app.
- 2) Access Intent to Graduate Petition from A&R webpage when you register for Winter/Spring 2024 courses and submit starting **October 16, 2023**.
- 3) Verification will be submitted on your behalf by the Admissions & Records (A & R) office no later than <u>March 15, 2024</u>. Electronic verification occurs automatically once you complete Step # 2 (see above).
