

Board Policy 5015

Residence Determination

Except for students seeking to enroll exclusively in career development and college preparation courses, and other courses for which no credit is given, students shall be classified at the time of each application for admission or registration as a resident or nonresident student.

A resident is any person who has been a bona fide resident of California for at least one year on the residence determination date. The residence determination date shall be the day immediately preceding the first day of a semester, winter, or summer session, for which the student applies to attend.

Residence classification shall be made for each student at the time application for admission is accepted or registration occurs and whenever a student has not been in attendance for more than one semester. A student previously classified as a nonresident may be reclassified as of any residence determination date.

The Registrar shall enact procedures to assure that residence determinations are made in accordance with Education Code and Title 5 regulations.
