Board Self-Evaluation

The Board is committed to assessing its own performance as a Board in order to identify its strengths and areas in which it may improve its functioning. Goals specifically related to the progress of diversity, equity, and inclusion shall be included in the Board's performance criteria.

On an annual basis, the Board establishes goals and evaluates its performance on the previous year's goals. The Board shall review and discuss its progress toward its annual goals on a quarterly basis during an Open Meeting of the Board.

Once a year, the Board shall conduct a self-evaluation on its performance of the previous year's goals. The self-evaluation will be presented and discussed at an open meeting of the Board. The results will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year.
