Dear Carolyn,

This is a request to remove El Camino Classified Employees-AFT Local 6142 as a participant in the Demand to Bargain and Information Request sent to Dr. Thomas Fallo and Dr Keith Curry on October 3, 2013 and October 7, 2013.

In reviewing your Demand to Bargain letter I see only a couple places where any of the concerns listed have an impact on the terms and conditions of our bargaining agreement. There is a mention of El Camino employees in item#8 Section 14 questioning what might happen if Compton work was assigned to El Camino employees, thereby potentially reduces Compton positions or employee hours. There is also a mention of El Camino employees in item#14 Section 25 expressing a concern with whose collective bargaining agreement applies if an El Camino employee physically works at the Compton campus. This Demand to Bargain letter seems to primarily express Compton employee concerns, not El Camino classified employee concerns.

AFT Local 6142 had an opportunity to participate with the amended agreement between the El Camino Community College District and the Compton Community College District. The two items mentioned above are not a concern to us. We have an understanding and an agreement with regards to those things. We feel we have already had the opportunity to bargain the effects and have no desire to be a participant in this action request.
