Dear Members of the Board:

I am pleased to present to you the Wednesday, February 17, Board agenda. As you recall, the February Board meeting will be held on Wednesday at 4:00 p.m. due to the President's Day holiday on Monday, February 15.

The consent agenda includes the following:

- A. Academic Affairs presents for second reading and adoption Board Policy 4240 (Academic Renewal). The Administrative Procedure for this Board Policy is included for your information. Also included for your information is a list of Program Reviews and/or CTE reviews completed in 2015 with a link to view a complete list of academic Program Reviews and two-year CTE reviews. You may recall that Program Reviews are conducted every four years, with CTE Programs undergoing review on a two-year cycle. Proposed changes to curriculum are also included in this agenda.
- B. Student and Community Advancement has three items on the agenda. There is a request that the Board of Trustees approve destruction of Placement Testing Records and accompanying materials, which are Class Three records. SCA also requests your approval of a \$2.6M grant from the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) for scholarships in the Nursing Program to support students from underrepresented minority groups and students from an educational and economically disadvantaged background. Lastly, SCA recommends that the Board of Trustees approve an amendment to a grant from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Academic Affairs Division. The grant will provide CTE certification training in Machine Tool Technology, Aerospace Fastener Manufacturing, Welding, HVAC, and Engineering Technology. The amendment extends the performance period for this grant.
- C. Administrative Services includes a three-year contract for independent financial audit services for Measure E general obligation bonds, as well as contracts with two providers to support international student recruitment. One of the two contractors will also serve as an F-1 Visa educational agent in addition to recruiting F-1 Visa students to ECC. One contract of note is a

recommended agreement with Ellucian to provide programming and systems consulting to the District for ECC's Colleague Enterprise Resource Planning application. Routine purchase orders and one contract amendment are also included in the agenda.

- D. Measure E includes expenditure updates, purchase orders and blanket purchase orders for Measure E general obligation bond projects. Three contracts relating to the Lot C Parking Structure project are included in the agenda. There is a recommended Bid Award to Bomel Construction for the Lot C Parking Structure Project as well. Lastly, the Board Agenda includes a recommendation to approve a settlement agreement between the District and Taisei Construction Corporation following the Arbitrator's award.
- E. Human Resources recommends employment and personnel changes and the approval of temporary and non-classified service employee actions.
- F. Compton Center includes two proposed partnership agreements between the El Camino Community College District, Compton Community College District, California State University, Dominguez Hills, and the Lynwood Unified School District and the Compton Unified School District, respectively. The agreements are focused on more closely linking the efforts of all parties to support student success and increase the college participation rates in the area.

There will be two closed session agenda items and no report out after the session.

The El Camino College Annual Factbook is a reference source containing trend data about students, student outcomes, and instructional programs and services. The data in the Factbook provide background information to facilitate policy analysis and decision-making. The Annual Factbook presents tables and graphs that contain enrollment trends for the last five academic years; the Pie charts present enrollment for the most recent academic year. Information has been disaggregated by age, gender and ethnicity where appropriate.

Demographic and enrollment data on ECC students was provided by the Chancellor's Office. Some of the data in the Special Programs section was extracted from the college's student database. In addition, data from the National Student Clearinghouse was used to provide transfer destination information. The National Student Clearinghouse is a national, non-profit organization that offers access to enrollment and degree records.

Institutional Research & Planning modified the appearance and mode of access to the Annual Factbook this year. The changes were made to enhance viewing, particularly via tablet or laptop, of the five-year trends in annual enrollment at El Camino College and El Camino College Compton Center.
