The following goals and priorities will inform Board meeting and workshop agendas, strategies, and activities, and will be the criteria for the 2018 Board self-evaluation.

The Board is committed to fulfilling the Board Duties and Responsibilities per Board Policy 2200, with particular attention to the following:

- 1. Represent the public interest
- 2. Assure fiscal health and stability
- 3. Advocate for the district
- 4. Complete required training as mandated:
 - a. Ethics, per AB 1234
 - b. Sexual harassment, per AB 1825
- 5. Liaise frequently and responsibly with District communities
- 6. Review and adopt a policy/procedure for the Superintendent/President search.

The Board is committed to its role related to leadership and support for College initiatives.

- 7. Expect and monitor the transition plan for the change in authority for Compton College
- 8. Monitor implementation of College plans and priorities for the institution with special attention to:
 - a. Enrollment management that will achieve 20,000 FTES by 2020
 - b. Improving rates of enrollment of in-district students
 - c. Improving student success in graduation and transfer rates
 - d. Improving student progress through remediation, including effective use of multiple measure in placement for English and math
 - e. Improving Board discussions and review of institutional effectiveness metrics in BP 1200
 - f. Expanding high school and ECC partnership and dual enrollment
 - g. Developing supportive services for students to address transportation and food insecurities
