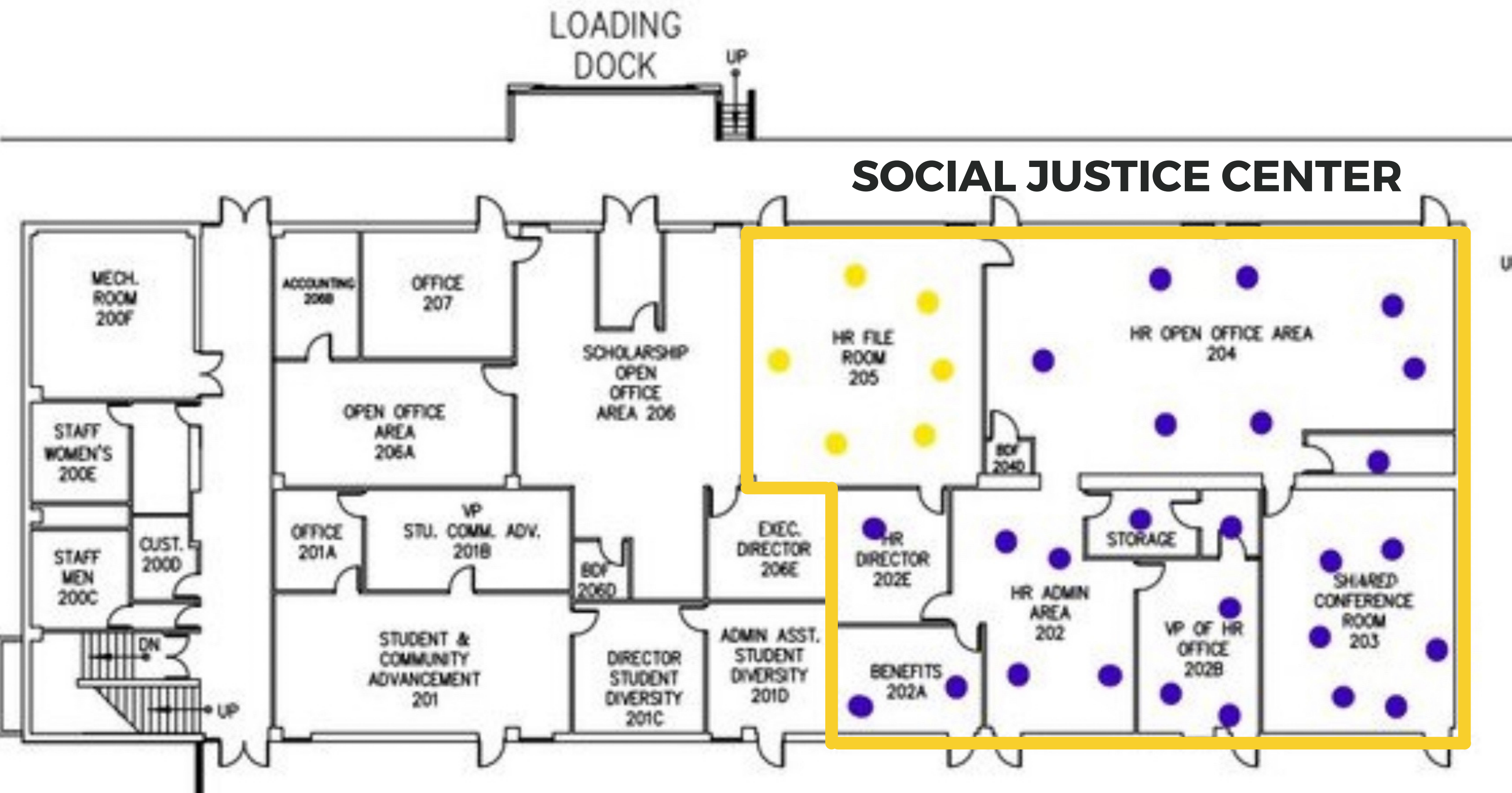

Expected Outcomes

Increase student engagement by encouraging involvement in Social Justice Center activities

Erase stigmas of race, culture, basic needs, and people; and provide a new avenue for dialogue of people to culminate in better understanding and eliminate the fear of differences

Creating an Anti-Racist environment while also working towards providing equitable opportunities for students to succeed not just in the classroom but in their personal lives as well

Increase students' locus of control, self-efficacy, and social capital to understand their own ability to utilize resources such as student services, academic support services, and technological support to reach their educational goals

Increase retention, persistence, degree attainment, and transfer rates for disproportionately impacted students

Increase # of students referred to student support programs and resources
