Art of Science/Science of Art - Frankenstein 200

The ECC Community Education department has been awarded a new Community Impact Arts Grant from the Los Angeles County Arts Commission to continue The Art of Science/ Science of Art programming. This new project will commemorate the 200th anniversary of Mary Shelley's Frankenstein with a 4-month long exploration of the Frankenstein myth in art and its influence on science and technology.



AB104 Adult Education Block Grant Regional Consortia 17-18

El Camino College has a mutualistic relationship with the regional Unified School District's (USD) Adult Schools and their 'feeder' schools in its service area. Within the South Bay Adult Education Consortium (SBAEC), each entity has areas of strength and specialty, which allows for a natural system of referral paths to each other which will ensure that all students receive the services they need to achieve their goals. SBAEC funded members include: Centinela Valley USD (CVUHSD), El Camino College (ECC), Inglewood USD (IUSD), Redondo Beach USD (RBUSD), and Torrance USD (TUSD). Per the AB104 budget bill language Section 84912, funding is apportioned to each regional consortium on a monthly allocation basis.

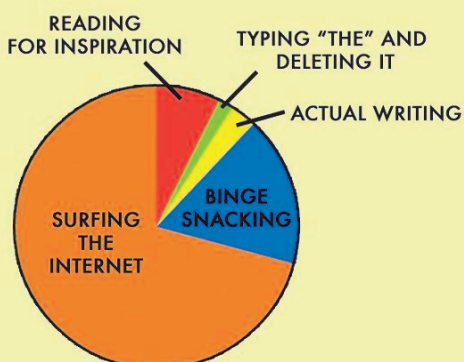

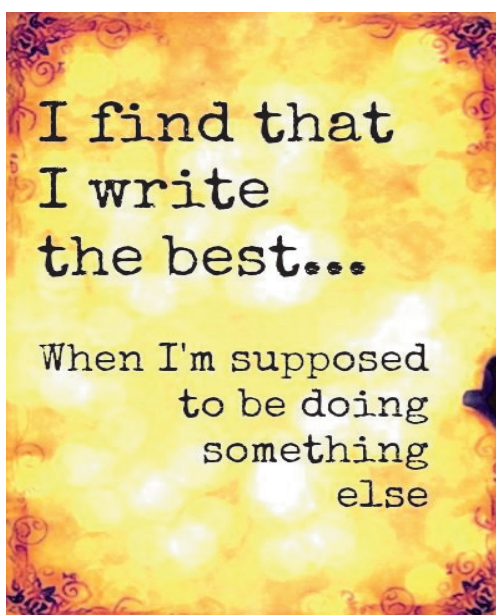
