El Camino College communications professors Diana Crossman and Francesca Bishop will debate two members of the forensics team at 2 p.m. April 30 in Marsee Auditorium.

Professor Crossman is a former forensics team coach and teaches a variety of communication studies courses at El Camino College. Accompanying her in the debate is Professor Bishop, current coach of the forensics team, who also teaches communication studies courses.

The debate will feature the hot-button issue of feminism's relevance in today's society. Crossman and Bishop will team up against two male forensics team students, arguing for the idea that feminism is relevant and significant to modern society. In their argument, the professors will set out to give a clarified understanding of what feminism truly means.
