Campaign 2016: Become an Informed Voter!

ECC Instructor Presents Guidelines on Choosing a Political Candidate

Just in time before the 2016 presidential campaign season gets underway, El Camino College instructor Joseph Evans will give a presentation designed to help participants become informed voters.

Titled "Choosing a presidential candidate: Five Communication and Argumentation Traits People Should Look for in a Political Candidate," the event is scheduled for 7 p.m. June 7 in Marsee Auditorium.

Evans is a coach for the El Camino College debate team and a communication studies professor at El Camino College. His presentation is geared toward El Camino College students and all registered voters who want to make informed decisions when heading to the polls. Research indicates that the "millennial" demographic group of people born in the years from the early 1980s to the early 2000s will be a key factor in deciding the victors.

In this lecture, Evans argues that people should be critical of a politician's public speaking and argumentation ability. He will offer five general traits that all voters, regardless of political party, should consider before casting their ballots.
