El Camino College Concert Band will perform a fall concert at 3 p.m. November 15 in Marsee Auditorium.

Directed by Dane Teter, ECC's director of instrumental music, this concert will include: Hazo's "Enchanted Spaces," Zdechlik's "Chorale and Shaker Dance," Strauss' "Die Fledermaus Overture," Dukas' "La Peri Fanfare," Standridge's "When the Spring Rain Begins to Fall," and Christensen's "Disney Around the World," among other selections.

The ECC Concert Band welcomes all woodwind, brass, and percussion musicians who can play at an intermediate level or higher. The band is dedicated to the rehearsal and performance of the finest traditional and contemporary wind band literature.

Professor Teter conducts the Concert Band and the Symphony Orchestra. He received his doctorate in music education from USC. A veteran conductor, Teter has worked with numerous bands, orchestras, and choirs from all over the Western United States. He frequently performs in El Camino College Artist-in-Residence recitals with his fellow faculty members and local musicians.
