ECC to Present “Elements of Process,” Fall Advanced Dance Concert

Dance concert features student work, faculty/guest choreographers

El Camino College’s dance students are gearing up for “Elements of Process,” the annual Fall Advanced Dance Concert scheduled for the first week of December.

El Camino College dance students will perform works from El Camino College faculty Liz Hoefner Adamis, Jessica Kondrath and Valerie Cabag and several student choreographers. The performance, “Elements of Process,” is inspired by the art of photography. Performances are set for 1 p.m. Dec. 1; 8 p.m. Dec. 2 and 3; and 3 p.m. Dec. 4 in the Campus Theatre.

The dance concert will also feature choreography from two guest artists. Suchi Branfman has worked nationally and internationally as a performer and dance educator, earning support from groups like the National Endowment for the Arts, California Arts Council, New York State Council for the Arts and Los Angeles Cultural Affairs Department. She teaches at Scripps College.

Andrew Pearson is a Los Angeles-based contemporary dancer and movement artist. He is a graduate of the Claire Trevor School of the Arts at the University of California, Irvine, where he received bachelor’s degrees in both dance and choreography. Andrew is in his fifth season as a member of Los Angeles Contemporary Dance Company and has worked as a choreographer in all facets of live performance.
