Italian Piano Virtuoso Beatrice Rana to Perform in El Camino College's Marsee Auditorium

Italian piano virtuoso Beatrice Rana will present a recital at 8 p.m. April 5 in El Camino College's Marsee Auditorium.

Rana's performance will feature J.S. Bach's "Goldberg Variations," a work consisting of an aria and a set of 30 variations. First published in 1741, the work is considered to be one of the most important examples of variation form.

The 24-year-old performer shot to stardom after claiming the Silver Medal and Audience Award at the 2013 Van Cliburn International Piano Competition. She has performed at venues such as Konzerthaus and Musikverein in Vienna, Tonhalle in Zurich, Wigmore Hall and Royal Festival Hall in London, and Théâtre des Champs-Élysées in Paris. She has also worked with world-famous conductors around the world.

In September 2015, she was named a BBC New Generation Artist, and in April 2016 she was awarded a fellowship from the Borletti-Buitoni Trust.
