El Camino College to Present “The Many Shades of Love” Opera Workshop *Annual spring performance highlights student work*

El Camino College will present its spring Opera Workshop, showcasing student work from the past semester at 8 p.m. June 8 in the Campus Theatre.

The Opera Workshop is designed to spotlight the work of outstanding vocal students who auditioned to be in the class. Directed by ECC professor Kevin Blickfeldt and accompanied by pianists Manuel Arellano and Eun Hyoung Nam, performances will follow the theme “The Many Shades of Love” and will include works from Mozart, Sondheim, Puccini and Bernstein.

Founded in 2004 by the late Hedley Nosworthy, a longtime ECC music professor, the Opera Workshop is intended to teach aspiring opera singers the skills necessary to move, act and sing while performing on stage. Students learn to master the ability to sing complex operatic works in English, Italian, French and German.
