El Camino College to Present an Evening of Music, from Classical to Jazz

El Camino College Dean of Fine Arts Berkeley Price will be joined by ECC faculty and accompanists to perform an uplifting night of music. Works from composers such as Carl Maria von Weber, Claude Debussy and big band leader Artie Shaw will fill Marsee Auditorium with classical, jazz and swing music at 8 p.m. Sept. 22.

Price is a clarinetist, conductor and musical educator. As a performing artist, his solo and ensemble work has brought him to Europe, China, Ukraine, Japan, Greece, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and Panama. He earned a bachelor's degree in music from Brigham Young University, in addition to a master's degree in music and a doctorate in musical arts from Eastman School of Music, where he also received the Clarinet Teaching Fellowship.
