## Campus Police

### Parking, Traffic and Safety

The Campus Police Department is in charge of the personal safety and security of all who attend classes, as well as all who are employed by El Camino College.

The Vehicle Code Laws of the State of California, the ordinances of Los Angeles County and the Traffic and Parking Regulations of the El Camino Community College District are in effect 24 hours per day, 7 days per week and are enforced by the El Camino Police Department pursuant to section 21113 (a) of the California Vehicle Code.

Anyone parking in district parking lots is required to display a valid El Camino College parking permit in his/her vehicle. Semester parking permits are available for purchase from the Cashiers Office located in the Administration Building. Daily parking permits are available for \$2.00 from parking permit machines located in the parking lots.

Parking regulations are enforced 7 days per week from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. throughout the year, including weekends and holidays, unless otherwise specified. Vehicles parking in staff parking areas must display a valid El Camino College staff parking permit. Students and the general public may park in staff parking areas on weekends and holidays with a valid El Camino College student or daily parking permit.

Parking regulations are posted throughout campus. Campus Police will issue municipal court citations to violators of these regulations. Parking violations are a minimum of \$30.00. Parking availability is subject to change and lots may be closed or restricted for special events.

The basic campus speed limit is 15 mph in all posted areas. All provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the Traffic Rules of the El Camino Community College District are strictly enforced. Police Officers may issue citations to violators of these regulations.

If you have lost property on campus, please stop by the Police Department Parking Services office Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Lost property not claimed within 90 days is disposed of in accordance with district policy.

The El Camino Police Department operates a campus courtesy Shuttle between the campus buildings and parking lots, Monday through Thursday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. You may obtain this service by calling the Police Department or by using one of the "POLICE" phones located throughout campus. The "POLICE" telephones can also be used for reporting emergencies and suspicious activity. You may reach the Police Department in an emergency situation by dialing 9-1-1 from any pay telephone on campus or by dialing (310) 660-3100 from a cellular telephone.

First aid, as well as help in all emergency situations, is provided through the Police Department.

The El Camino Community College District shall not be liable for the loss or damage caused to any vehicle parked in a district parking lot.

## Student Right to Know Information

The El Camino College Police Department provides professional law enforcement services to the El Camino College campus community. The Police Department is located at the corner of Redondo Beach and Crenshaw boulevards in Parking Lot K. The Police Department provides emergency first aid service in emergency situations. You may reach the Police Department by calling (310) 660-3100.

The Police Department is open 24 hours per day.
