# Prerequisite Clearance El Camino College

If a course has a **Prerequisite**, you will need to have the appropriate clearance on file in order to be able to register for it. (If a course has a **Recommended Preparation**, you do not need to have a clearance.)

## English and Mathematics Placement Survey in MyECC

Follow these steps if you are registering for an English or Math course, or a course that has a prerequisite of English or Math.

- 1. Sign into MyECC
- 2. On the Student Home Screen, click the link for the English and Mathematics Placement Survey
- 3. Answer the questions on each page of the survey. Make sure to estimate years of high school attendance, grade level, highest English/Math course completed, etc., <u>based on when you will be taking classes at El Camino College</u>.

## English and Mathematics Placement Survey

Required for new or returning students who have not yet taken their first English or Mathematics course.

For example, if you are currently in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade and enrolling for the summer or fall after 10<sup>th</sup> grade, make sure to answer that you will be in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, select the highest English/Math classes you will have completed by that time, and estimate your grades in those classes.

After submitting the survey, you will see a summary of your responses. Within 1-2 business days, you will receive an email from our Assessment Office to your @elcamino.edu email address with your English and Math Placements.

The <u>day after</u> you receive your placements, you will be able to register for English and Math courses.

NOTE: Students must have completed 3 years of high school in the United States to receive English Placement using this survey. Students must have completed 10<sup>th</sup> grade to receive Math Placement using this survey. Otherwise, students must contact the appropriate Academic Division about placement:

#### **English Placement Results**

You are eligible to enroll directly into transfer-level English. According to your High School GPA, your course placement is English 1A. Students who qualify for English 1A may choose to enroll in English 1A + 1AS (with support). If you are enrolling in English 1A + 1AS, search first for a section of English 1AS. Every section of English 1AS is linked to a section of English 1A.

You are eligible to enroll directly into a transfer-level mathematics course. Below, you will find two math placements: one for general education math and the second one for students considering a major in business, science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (BSTEM) fields.



- Completed coursework at another U.S. college/institution
- Advance Placement (AP) Exam score of 3 or higher (must attach a copy of AP test score from College Board)
- "Standard Exceeded" score on the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)

Please allow 3-5 business days for processing online clearance requests. You will be notified via the email provided on the form.

NOTE: Students who have not yet received their AP Exam scores must email the appropriate <u>Academic Division</u> about clearance (see below).
