SENATE

In October, we had some great and informative Senate meetings! On Oct. 2nd ASO members went through the second reading of the Accountability By-Law, which reconstructs the attendance and accountability policy in ASO. The ASO body also discussed and approved the GAI By-Law which provides guidelines that would manage ASO's use of AI. ASO also discussed and approved the Stipend Evaluation Process.

On Oct. 9th the ASO body discussed and passed the Accountability By-Law. The College Night event was also sanctioned. ASO also discussed and passed the Finance Budget for Candy Crawl.

On Oct. 16th the ASO body sanctioned the Candy Crawl event. We also went over and passed another Candy Crawl Finance item.*

On Oct. 23rd, ASO approved the Student Voter Project and Sweet Solutions event budgets. We also sanctioned the Cultural Feast Event. The ASO body passed the CARE & CalWorks Holiday budget. ASO also passed the FYE Field Trip Holiday budget.

For Oct. 30th the Sweet Solutions and Club Rush events were sanctioned. ASO also reviewed the SLD Name Update By-Law, which provides an SLD name update to the ASO By-Laws. Also, the Finals Madness Budget was approved by ASO.
