Currently they are unaware of how many of the 500 students served that has the aso benefits pass purchased. 100K from Bob will be used for Officals Costs. In the past ASO funded only 45.9K. The other 10K laundry, supplies, 5K student athlete insurance deductibles remainder is going to be spent on transportation. From ASO 25K meals, 25K backpacks, 50K apparel. Backpack and Apparel can be basic needs under FCMAT.

Uzair argues that gifts of any kind is not allowed under FCMAT therefore, due to an equity issue. Pg180 says that students should be benefited at large.

The issue we are having it that we are not funding any program with items, we are concerned about the equity issue that only allows a few students access to the care package. If all of the items were provided to all 500 students that are in athletics, the concern is now the "gift" portion. The apparel is now a tangible or resold for a profit. The support can also be considered double dipping.

The fundraising will continue to happen to better the students in that specific athletics department branding, banquets, facility upgrades, etc.

The only games that charge admission is the football games. A lot of those who attend are students so they dont want to charge.
