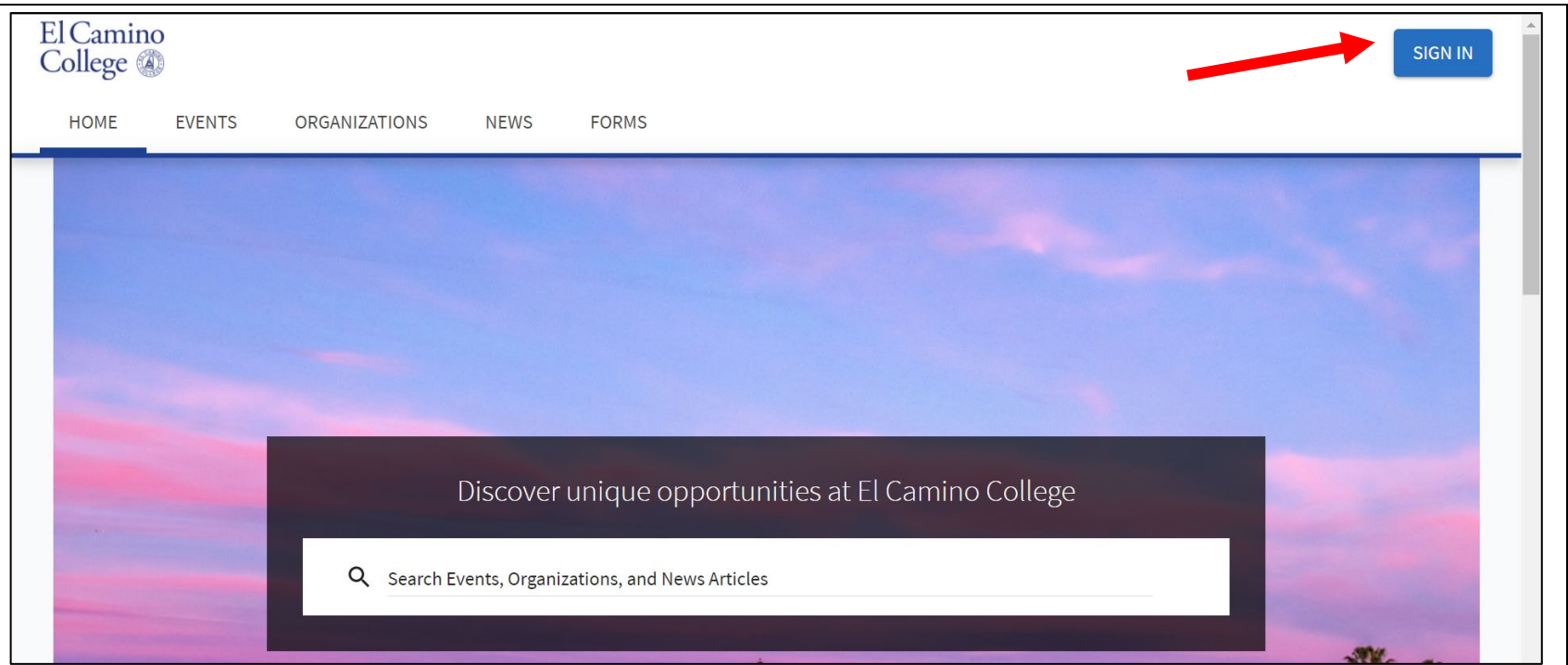


Create an Engage Profile

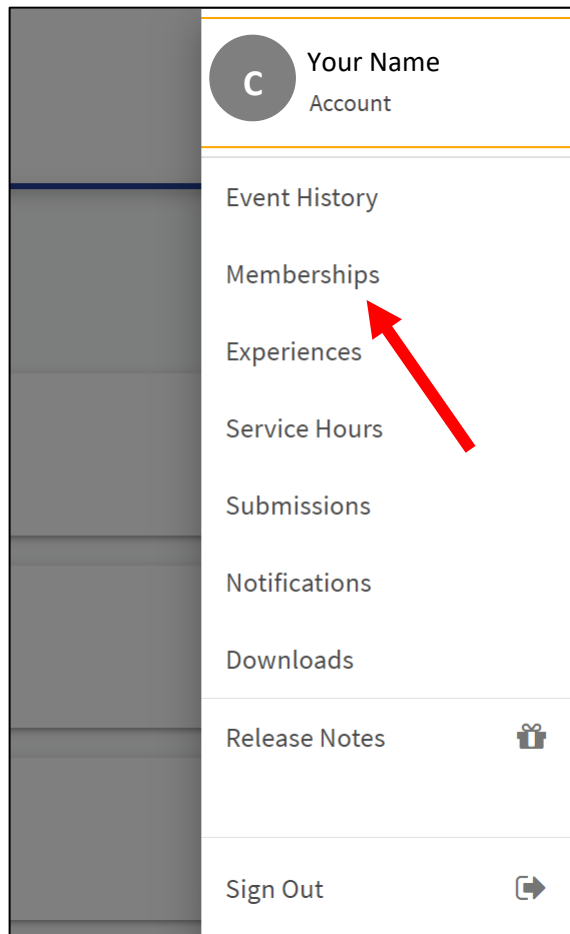
