Instructor Spotlight: Deena Lee Appointed as South Bay's First Female Fire Chief

Deena Lee, **El Camino Fire Academy** instructor of more than 15 years, was recently appointed by the City of El Segundo as the new Fire Chief, effective November 2, 2021, following the retirement of Fire Chief Chris Donovan. Chief Lee is a twenty-year fire service veteran and will be the South Bay's first female fire chief. She will also be the only female fire chief in the broader Ventura/Los Angeles/Orange tri-county coastal area.

"Drive, hard work, and dedication to helping people has led me to the position of fire chief," stated Deena Lee. "I follow an 'if you see it, you can be it' philosophy. I want to empower and inspire girls and women to pursue leadership positions." Chief Lee is a dedicated public safety professional who is committed to community engagement and volunteers with many non-profit



organizations, including the Women's Fire Alliance. She dedicates her time to mentoring young women and being a positive role model in the community.

Chief Lee began her career in the fire service as a volunteer firefighter for the City of La Habra Heights. She then joined the City of La Verne Fire Department as an apprentice firefighter. She promoted through the ranks and worked as a fire captain for several years. There she gained experience as a supervisor and had the opportunity to respond to multiple wildland fires. Chief Lee joined the El Segundo Fire Department in 2003 as a firefighter and was promoted to fire captain in 2007 and later battalion chief in 2019. Lee was appointed to acting fire chief July 6, 2021.

Chief Lee holds a bachelor's degree in fire science from Columbia Southern University and has certifications for Firefighter I and II, Fire Officer, Chief Fire Officer, Urban Search and Rescue and 100+ other fire service certifications. In addition to teaching at the El Camino Fire Academy, Lee is also a certified instructor with the California State Fire Marshal.


Program Spotlight: El Camino Partners with NBCU Academy for Journalism Training and Scholarships

Program Spotlight: El Camino's Entrepreneurial Studies to Hold Business Pitch Contest



El Camino College students who have been dreaming of starting their own business will be able to compete in a business plan pitch competition to make their entrepreneurial dreams a reality. On November 18,

students can compete in the "Perfect Pitch Competition," and present to a panel of judges from the community who are experienced entrepreneurs.

To qualify for the competition, students must enroll in two preparatory sessions where they will have an opportunity to fine-tune their business plan and practice their business proposal delivery. A \$500 prize, made possible by **JPMorgan Chase** through their **minority entrepreneur** program, will be awarded to the winning pitch to be used for the creation and implementation of their business idea.

"The Perfect Pitch Competition is an opportunity for our students to take control of their future," explains Dr. Virginia Rapp, Dean of Business at El Camino College. "Students across campus will receive support from business faculty and advisors on their business concept as well as their presentation skills. Participants will deliver their business presentation virtually and vie for the cash prize."

El Camino business management professor Melissa Som de Cerff says that the contest is a perfect launch pad for those students who have been thinking about starting their own business. Those interested in developing their own small business should consider the **Entrepreneurial Studies Program** offered by the Business Division.
