BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Dean of Fine Arts, play percussion instruments for dance classes and performances.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Assist instructor in providing accompaniment for dance classes and performances.

Improvise or adapt percussion rhythms for individuals and groups.

Play percussion instruments for dance soloists and groups.

Improvise and perform music with appropriate rhythm by watching the movement of dancers.

Perform or record music for class projects and presentations.

Perform traditional rhythmic patterns of different ethnic styles, create and sustain progressions of mixed meter and irregular rhythmic patterns, and adapt musical interpretation with sensitivity to dance movement.

Perform related duties as required.
