Judging Criteria: Nominees will be considered based on their contributions to women's and girls' causes or to service at the college or community level that supports this year's National Women's History Month theme: "Moving Forward Together! Women Educating & Inspiring Generations"

Through their efforts, they have served as an inspiration for all generations — both past and present.
