As we walk the path into March, embrace the beautiful days ahead, filled with sunshine and warmth. Springtime is just around the corner!



Community Spotlight: Vaccination Site Now at El Camino College



El Camino College became an authorized LA County COVID-19 vaccination site in January 2021. Administered and staffed by **Curative**, the site has expanded to offer vaccines by appointment only to members of the public age 65 and over and to health care workers. By mid February, Curative was responsible for vaccinating 280 people an hour, and 2,000 people a day. Due to the reduction of LA County vaccination availability, the release of new doses has decreased significantly and only second dose appointments are currently available. Please continue to check the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health website for updated vaccination information.

El Camino College can now play an even greater role in helping combat the COVID-19 pandemic. Additionally, ECC employees and students age 65 and over have convenient access to a vaccination site.

Campus Spotlight: Master Plan and Facilities Update

El Camino College is proud of the campus renovations being made. Even though campus remains closed, we are building a better El Camino College by continuing the modernization plan. Here's an update of the current projects:

- New Music Building is in the design phase
- Arts Complex began construction in November and will be completed in 2022
- Behavioral & Social Sciences broke ground and will be completed in 2022
- Bookstore Café renovation will begin in April 2021
- Pool & Classroom Complex was completed in fall 2020
- Administration building was completed in spring 2020
