Donor Spotlight: In Loving Memory of Frances Ford



It is with deep sadness that we share the news of the passing of longtime Foundation friend and donor, Frances Ford, on December 20th at the age of 95, from living a good, long, happy life. Frances' husband, Warren E. Ford, taught Chemistry at El Camino College for 36 years. Professor Ford encouraged his students and instilled confidence in them that they could succeed and achieve their educational goals.

When Professor Ford passed away in 2003, Frances established three endowed scholarships in his memory at El Camino that will continue to enable 12 students each year to receive a \$2,000 scholarship: the Warren E. Ford Memorial Chemistry Scholarship; Warren E. Ford Memorial Nursing Scholarship; and Frances Ford Scholarship for Nursing. Frances loved El Camino College and her scholarship recipients, and a highlight each year was to see her at the Scholarship Awards Dinner when she would meet "her" students. She wanted to know each of them, and engaged with them to discuss their career goals and aspirations.

Her discreet generosity and thoughtfulness were a cornerstone of her life. An avid traveler, she and Warren made lifelong friendships with those they met on their travels. A gifted writer, story teller and memory maker, Frances enjoyed sharing tales of her family, travels and experiences.

In 2018, Frances was awarded the first-ever **Community Gratitude Award** by the El Camino College Foundation for her many years of philanthropic support totaling over \$1 million in scholarships and other student success programs. Frances had an infectiously positive attitude that will be greatly missed. For those of us who knew her, our lives are better for it.

Department Spotlight: El Camino Awarded \$100K Journalism Grant Through Newly Launched NBCU Academy



Comcast's **NBCUniversal News Group** recently launched NBCU Academy, a journalism training and development program that's set to partner with 17 academic institutions across the U.S., including El Camino College. El Camino College is the only community college in California to join the other colleges and universities nationwide. The program selected only two California institutions of higher education, with California State University, Fullerton being the other appointed school.

The El Camino College Foundation was awarded the \$100,000 grant by NBCU Academy in December 2020. Through its award-winning **Journalism Department**, El Camino College will award multiple scholarships annually to journalism students to promote

excellence in the disciplines of journalism, news gathering, reporting, and communications. El Camino College's student-produced publications, ***The Union*** newspaper and ***Warrior Life*** magazine, are honored regularly with state and national awards for writing, photography, and design.
